


#### Installing the Front Splash Guards

1. Turn the steering wheel fully counterclockwise.




2. Remove the two self-tapping screws from the left front inner fender.

3. Using a pushpin, pierce the center of the two clips on the left front inner fender.






5. Turn the steering wheel fully clockwise, and repeat steps 2 through 4 for the right side of the vehicle.


6. Remove the three self-tapping screws and one clip from the rear bumper and left rear inner fender.




