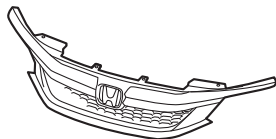

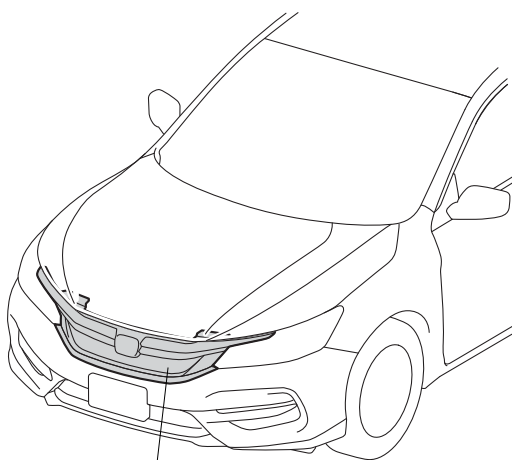

NOTE: Be careful not to damage the paint finish.

1. Disconnect the negative cable from the battery.
2. Attach masking tape to the front bumper, headlights and front fenders as shown.

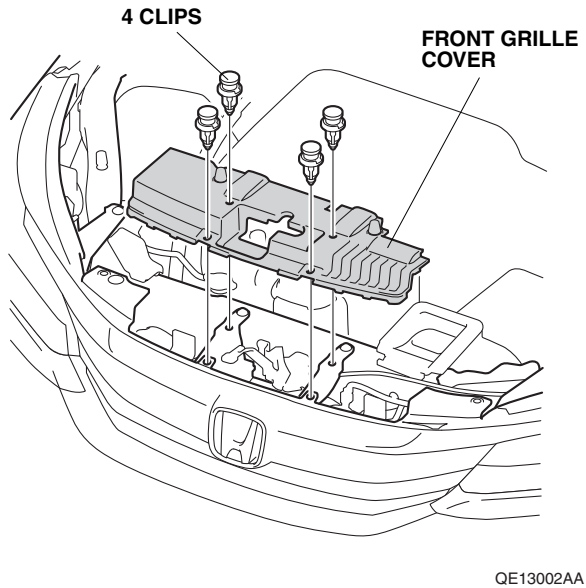

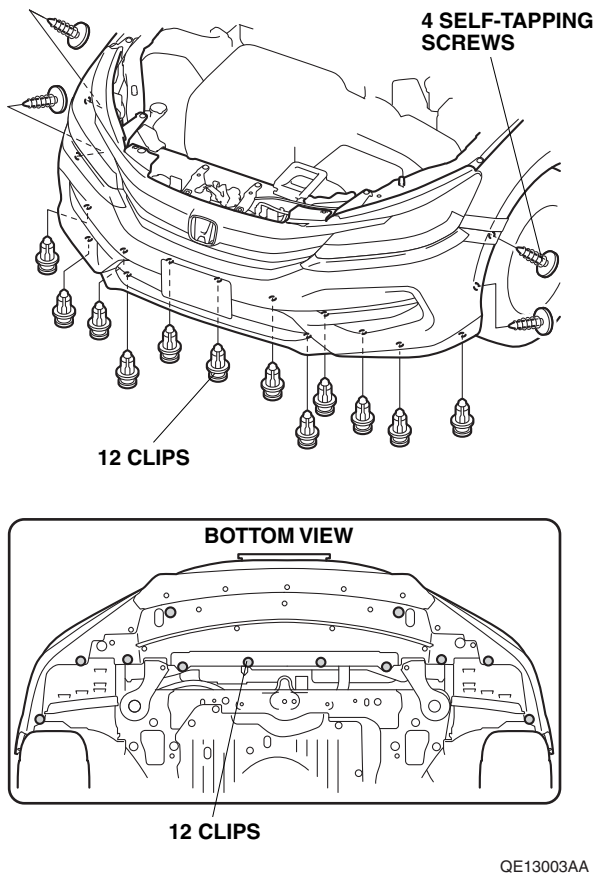

3. Remove the front grille cover.

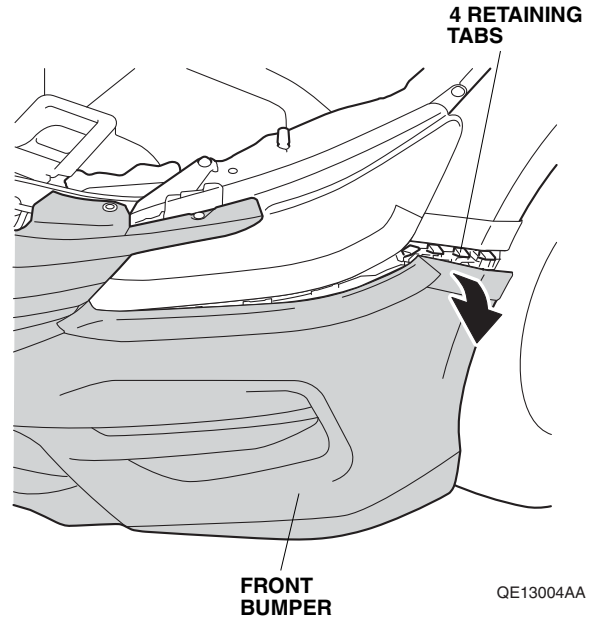


4. Remove the front bumper.

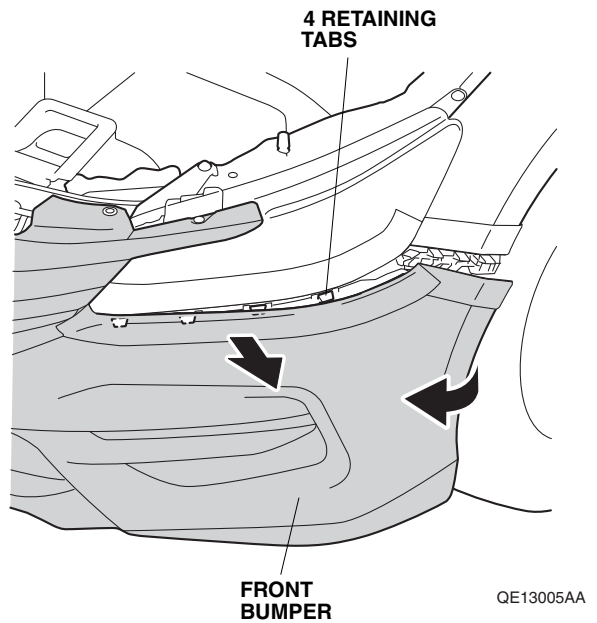
- Remove the four self-tapping screws, twelve clips.



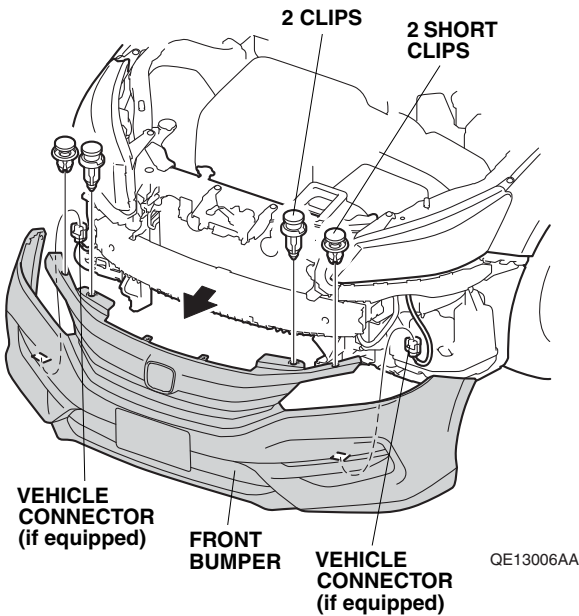
- Release the four retaining tabs on each side.



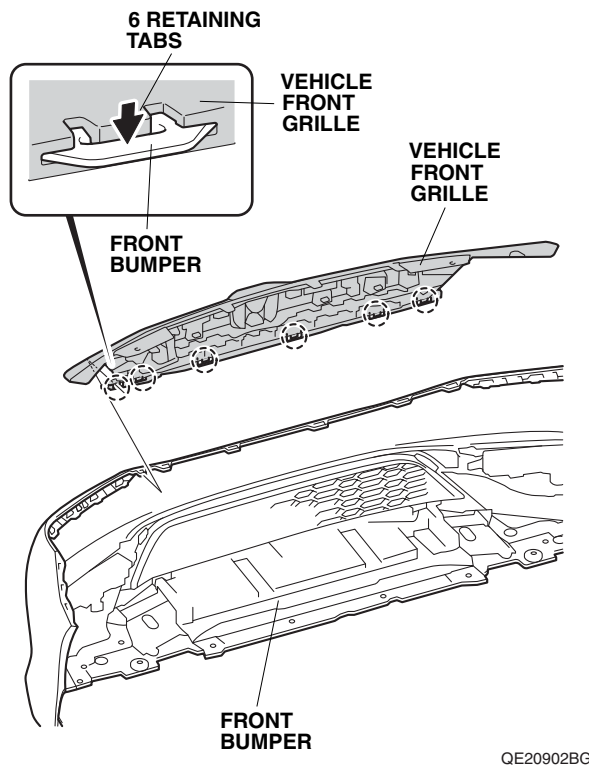
- Release the four retaining tabs on each side.



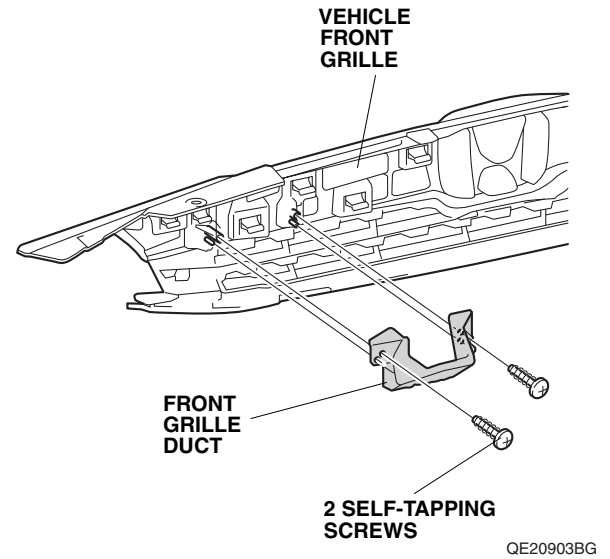
- Remove the two clips and two short clips.
- With the help of an assistant, remove the front bumper.
- Place the front bumper on a blanket.



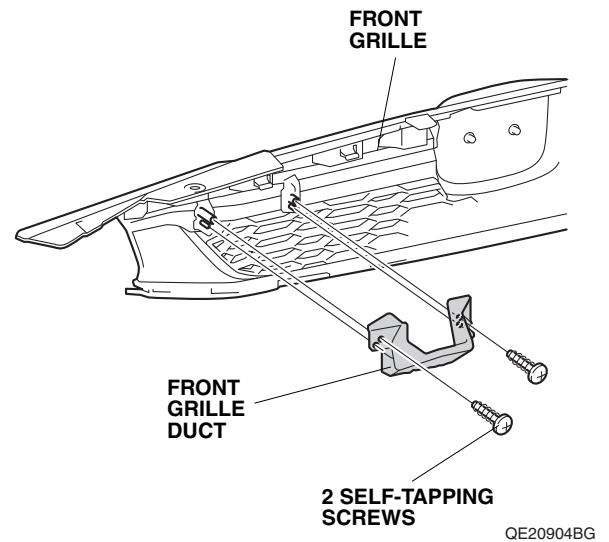
5. Remove the vehicle front grille.



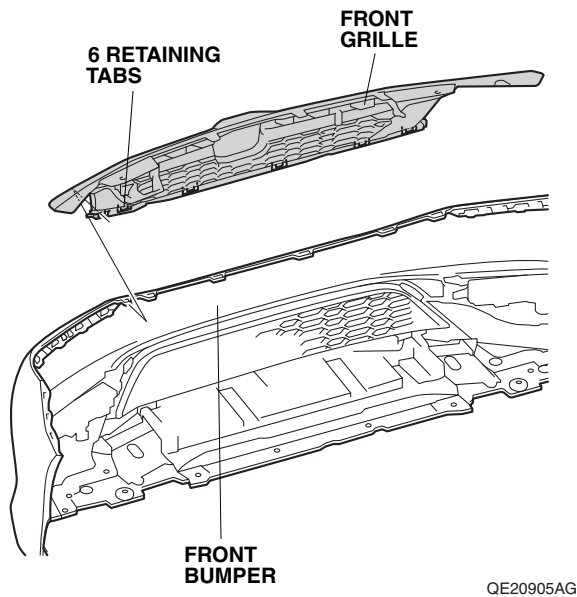
6. Remove the front grille duct.



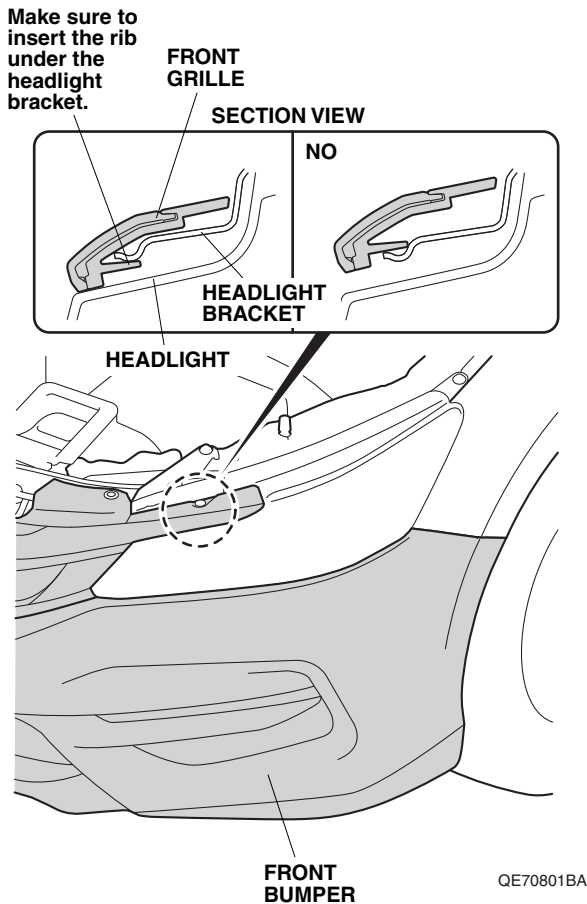
7. Install the front grille duct to the front grille with the two self-tapping screws removed in step 6.



8. Install the front grille on the front bumper with the six retaining tabs.



9. With the help of an assistant, install the front bumper.



10. Check that all wire harnesses are routed properly and all connectors are plugged in.
11. Install all removed parts.
12. Connect the negative cable to the battery.
13. Press and hold the audio unit power button for two seconds to restore the audio and navi; (if equipped) system functions.
14. Reset the clock (vehicles without navigation).
