



1. Disconnect the negative cable from the battery.




2. Remove the left and right front grille cover.

 - · Apply masking tape as shown.




 Remove the six self-tapping screws and 17 clips as shown.



• With the help of an assistant, release the seven retaining tabs on each side.




- With the help of an assistant, remove the front bumper, and unplug the vehicle connectors (if equipped).
- Place the front bumper on a blanket.




4. Remove the front grille from the front bumper.



5. Install the front grille molding to the new front grille.



6. Install the new front grille to the front bumper.



- 7. Check that all wire harnesses are routed properly and all connectors are plugged in.
- 8. Install all removed parts.
- 9. Connect the negative cable to the battery.
- 10. Press and hold the audio unit power button for 2 seconds to restore the audio and navi (if equipped) system functions.
- 11. Set the clock on vehicles without navigation.
- 12. If necessary, restore the systems back to normal operation as described in the service information.
