#### Illustration of the Illuminated Door Sill Trims Installed on the Vehicle








#### Installing the front illuminated door sill trims and rear door sill trims


19. Align the right front illuminated door sill trim with the masking tapes attached in step 7, and position the right front illuminated door sill trim.




20. Reinstall the door opening seal, and using a felt-tip pen to mark the door opening seal as shown.



21. Pull away the door opening seal, and remove the right front illuminated door sill trim.




22. Using an utility knife, cut the door opening seal at the mark made in step 20.






- 31. Remove the masking tapes.
- 32. Peel back the adhesive backings, and tape them to the front surface of the right rear door sill trim with masking tape. Remove the other adhesive backing.




33. Using one alcohol swab, thoroughly clean the right rear step garnish where the right rear door sill trim will attach.



34. Install the right rear door sill trim to the right rear step garnish.




35. While applying light pressure against the right rear door sill trim, carefully remove the adhesive backings.





#### **Routing the Door Sill Trim Harness**


37. Unplug the vehicle connectors from the fuse box as shown.



38. Release the fuse box.




39. Using isopropyl alcohol on a shop towel, thoroughly clean the fuse case where the fuse label will attach. Attach the fuse label (2A STEP ILLUMI) to the fuse case on the door sill trim harness.





40. Unplug the vehicle 13-pin connector, and plug it into the door sill trim harness 13-pin connector.




- 41. Plug the remaining door sill trim harness 13-pin connector into the fuse box.
- 42. Reinstall the fuse box.


43. Route the door sill trim harness as shown. Align the green tape on the door sill trim harness with the hole on the instrument panel, and secure the door sill trim harness to the instrument panel with one wire tie.



44. Secure the door sill trim harness to the vehicle harness with three wire ties.




45. Using isopropyl alcohol on a shop towel, thoroughly clean the vehicle panel where the aluminum tapes will attach.





48. Route the left front illuminated door sill trim harness, and secure it to the vehicle harness with three wire ties.

49. Plug the door sill trim harness 2-pin connector into the left front illuminated door sill trim harness 2-pin connector.




50. Using scissors, cut one urethane tape in half, and attach one piece of urethane tape around the 2-pin connectors.


NOTE: Do not cover the connecter lock.

51. Secure the 2-pin connectors to the vehicle harness with one wire tie.


52. Route the door sill trim harness, and secure it to the instrument panel with one wire tie. If the vehicle is already equipped with other accessory harness, secure the door sill trim harness to the other accessory harness with one wire tie as shown.




 Route the door sill trim harness, and secure it to the vehicle frame with one wire tie.




54. Route the door sill trim harness, and secure it to the vehicle frame with two wire ties.



55. Route the door sill trim harness along the vehicle frame.




56. Using isopropyl alcohol on a shop towel, thoroughly clean the vehicle panel where the aluminum tapes will attach.



57. Using scissors, cut one aluminum tape, and secure the right front illuminated door sill trim harness to the vehicle panel with the three pieces of aluminum tape as shown.


58. Plug the door sill trim harness 2-pin connector into the right front illuminated door sill trim harness 2-pin connector.




- 59. Attach one piece of urethane tape cut in step 50 around the 2-pin connectors.
- 60. Secure the 2-pin connectors to the vehicle harness with one wire tie.

 Secure the right front illuminated door sill trim harness to the hole in the vehicle panel with the wire tie with clip B.


If the vehicle is equipped with the vehicle unit, using diagonal cutters, cut the clip portion off of one wire tie with clip B. Secure the right front illuminated door sill trim harness to the vehicle harness with cut wire tie with clip B.



62. Using isopropyl alcohol on a shop towel, thoroughly clean the vehicle panel where the aluminum tape will attach.



- 63. Bundle up the excess right front illuminated door sill trim harness, and secure it to the vehicle panel with one aluminum tape.
- 64. Secure the door sill trim harness to the holes in the vehicle frame with two wire ties with clip A.



- 65. Check that all wire harnesses are routed properly and all connectors are plugged in.
- 66. Reinstall all removed parts.
- 67. Reconnect the negative cable to the battery.
- 68. Press and hold the radio power button for two seconds to restore the radio and navi (if equipped) system functions.
- 69. Reset the clock on vehicle without navigation.
- 70. Restore the systems back to normal operation as described in the Service Manual if necessary.

#### **Check the Operation of the Illuminated Door Sill Trims**

 Make sure the light comes on when you open each door.
