Installing the Interior Panels


 Using one alcohol swab, thoroughly clean the passenger's dashboard trim panel where the passenger's side panel will attach.




 Peel back the adhesive backings, and tape them to the front surface of the passenger's side panel with masking tape. Remove the remaining adhesive backings.




3. Attach the passenger's side panel to the passenger's dashboard trim panel as shown.




4. While applying light pressure against the passenger's side panel, carefully remove the taped adhesive backings.




- 5. Using the palm of your hand, firmly press the passenger's side panel against the passenger's dashboard trim panel.
- Using one alcohol swab, thoroughly clean the driver's dashboard panel where the driver's side panel will attach.




 Peel back the adhesive backings, and tape them to the front surface of the driver's side panel with masking tape. Remove the remaining adhesive backing.




8. Attach the driver's side panel to the driver's dashboard panel as shown.




While applying light pressure against the driver's side panel, carefully remove the taped adhesive backings.




- 10. Using the palm of your hand, firmly press the driver's side panel against the driver's dashboard panel.
- 11. Using one alcohol swab, thoroughly clean the left front door where the left front door panel will attach.




12. Peel back the adhesive backings, and tape them to the front surface of the left front door panel with masking tape. Remove the remaining adhesive backings.



13. Line up and attach the left front door panel to the left front door as shown.




14. While applying light pressure against the left front door panel, carefully remove the taped adhesive backings.




- 15. Using the palm of your hand, firmly press the left front door panel against the left front door.
- Using one alcohol swab, thoroughly clean the left rear door where the left rear door panel will attach.




17. Peel back the adhesive backings, and tape them to the front surface of the left rear door panel with masking tape. Remove the remaining adhesive backings.
