





NOTE: The tonneau cover cannot be stored on the cargo floor position with a cargo tray installed.


If the vehicle is equipped with a subwoofer, continue with step 1; otherwise, go to step 2.

With Subwoofer

Using a scissors, cut the cargo tray in the area shown.



Open the hatch, and fold down the separator. Place the cargo tray inside the vehicle, and align the rear end to the cargo area as shown.
