

#### Illustration of the Black Emblems Installed on the Vehicle





#### NOTE:


- Be careful not to damage the body paint finish.
- This kit should be installed only if the ambient air temperature is 60°F (15°C) or above.
- To allow the adhesive to cure, do not wash the vehicle for 24 hours. Make sure the your customer is aware of this
- 1. Disconnect the negative cable from the battery.
- 2. Remove the rear window wiper arm assembly.




3. Remove the tailgate upper trim panel.



4. Remove the left and right tailgate side trim panels.




5. Apply masking tape as shown.





- 56. Install all removed parts.
- 57. Connect the negative cable to the battery.
- 58. Press and hold the audio unit power button for 2 seconds to restore the audio and navi (if equipped) system functions.
- 59. Set the clock on vehicles without navigation.
- 60. If necessary, restore the systems back to normal operation as described in the service information.
