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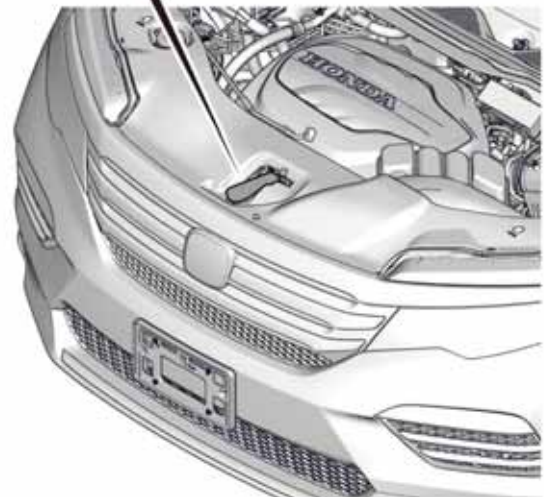
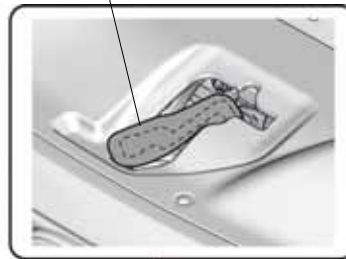
## INSTALLATION

**Customer Information:** The information in this installation instruction is intended for use only by skilled technicians who have the proper tools, equipment, and training to correctly and safely add equipment to your vehicle. These procedures should not be attempted by "do-it-yourselfers."

### NOTE:

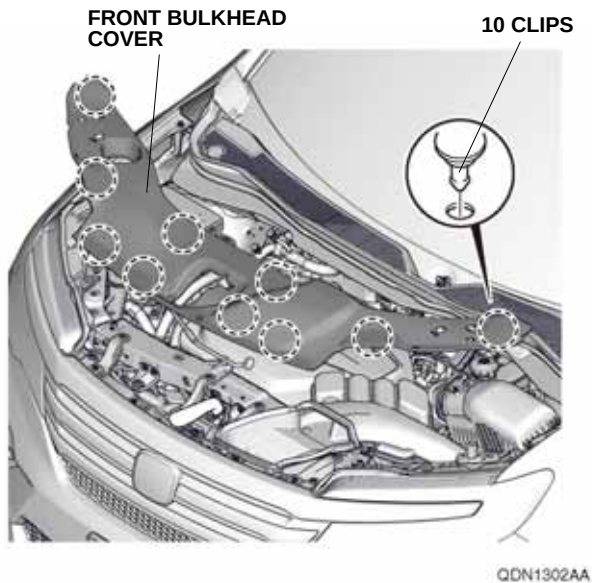
- Be careful not to damage the vehicle.
1. Wrap a shop towel around the hood latch

HOOD LATCH  
(Wrap with a shop towel.)

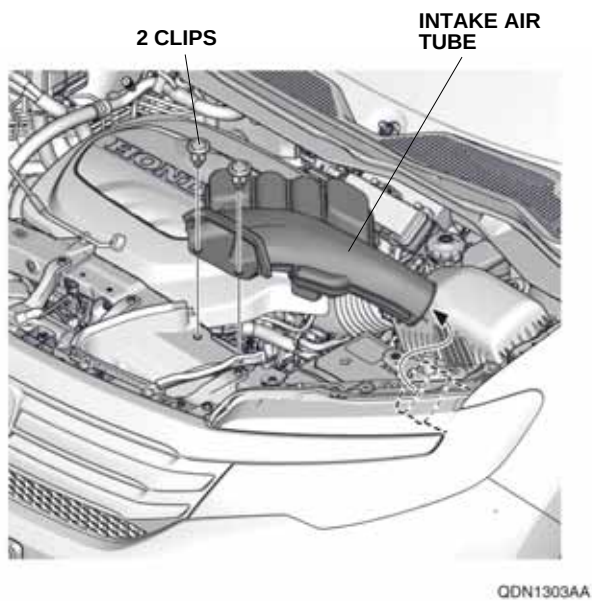


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- Remove the front bulkhead cover.

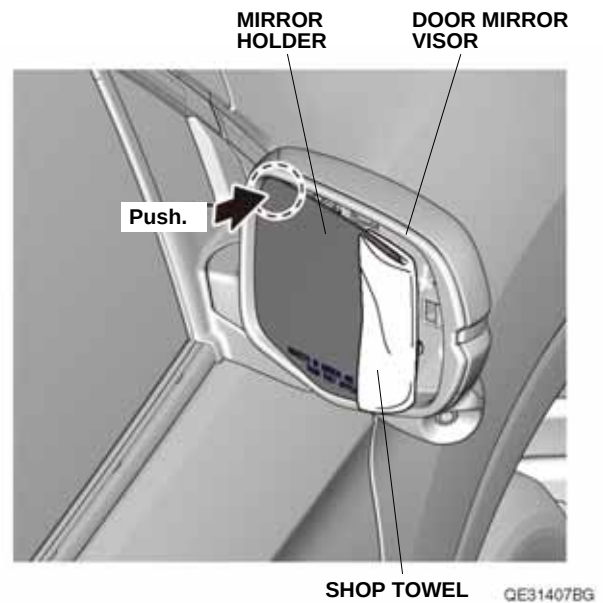


- Remove the intake air tube.

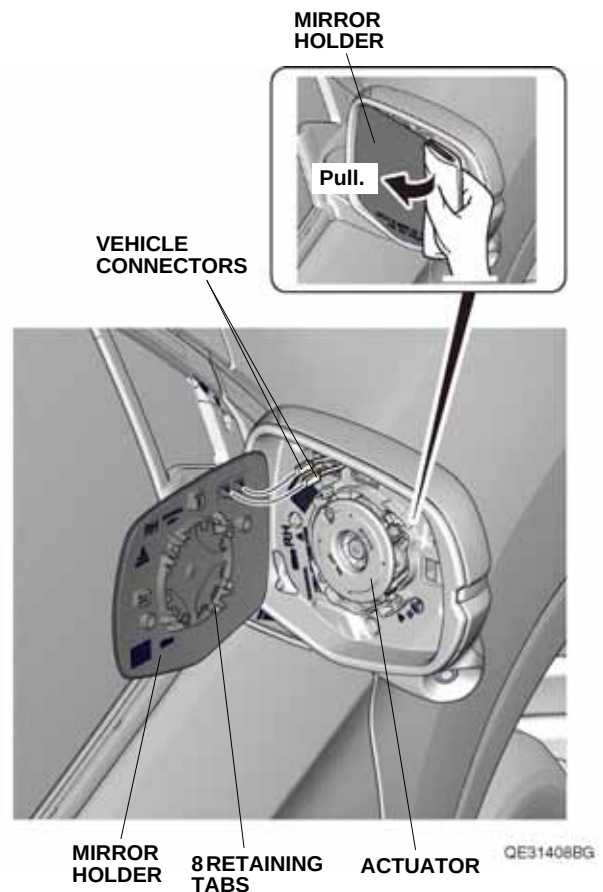


- Disconnect the negative cable from the battery, then wait at least 3 minutes before starting work.

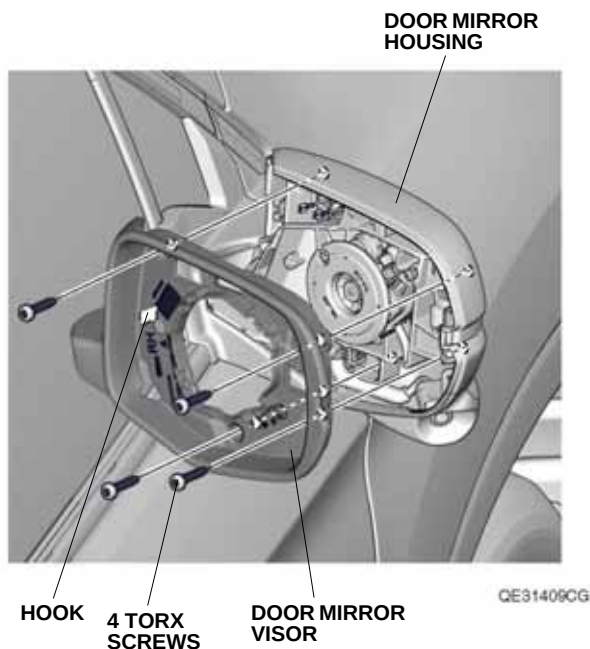
- Insert the shop towel between the mirror holder and the door mirror visor to protect the vehicle as shown.



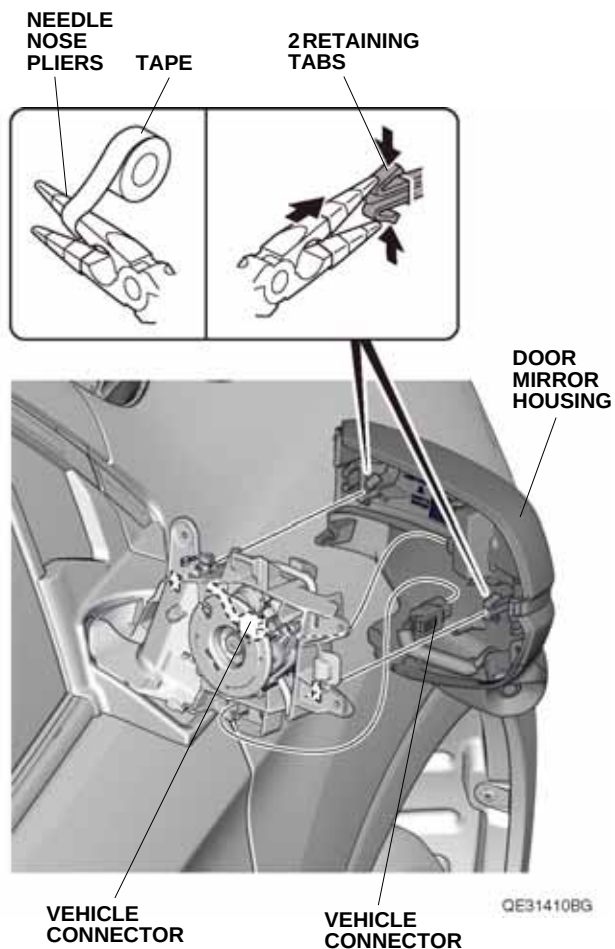
- Remove the mirror holder, and unplug the vehicle connectors.



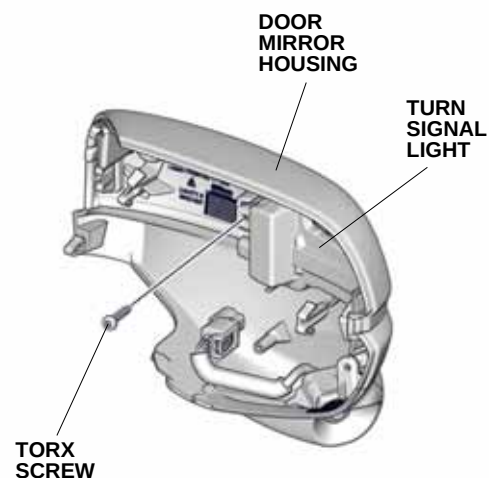
4. Remove the door mirror visor.



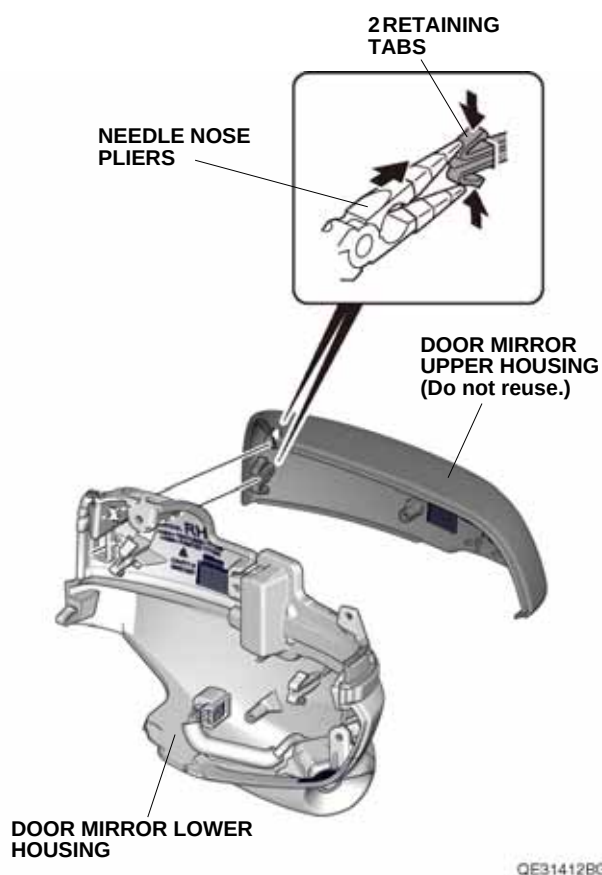
5. Using needle nose pliers wrapped with tape, remove the door mirror housing, and unplug the vehicle connectors.



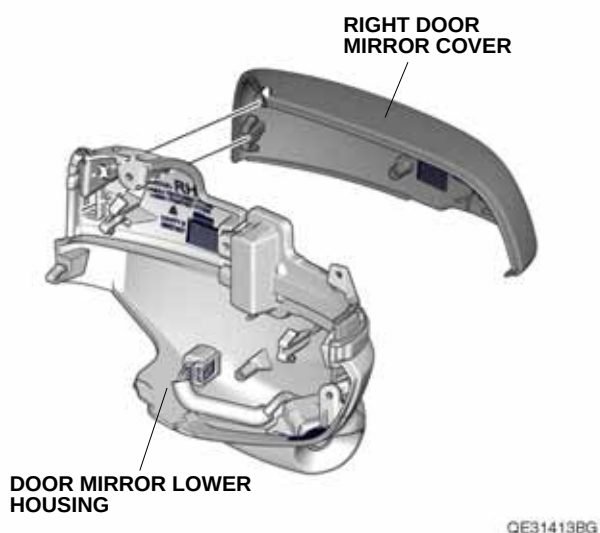
6. Remove the TORX screw from the turn signal light.



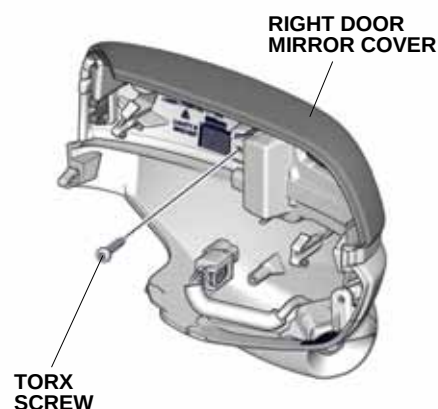
7. Using the needle nose pliers, remove the door mirror upper housing.



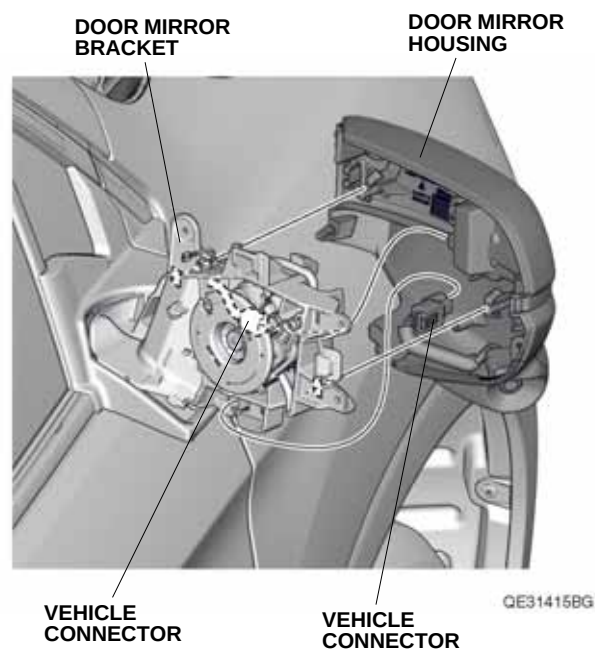
8. Install the right door mirror cover on the door mirror lower housing.



9. Secure the right door mirror cover with the TORX screw removed in step 6.



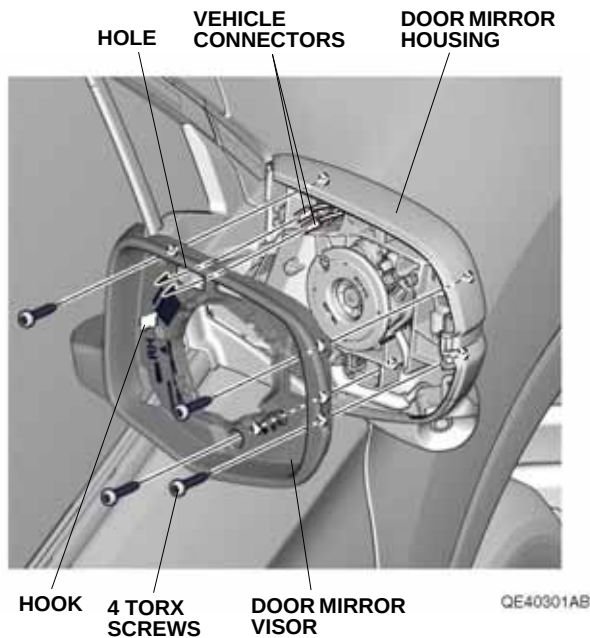
10. Plug in the vehicle connectors.



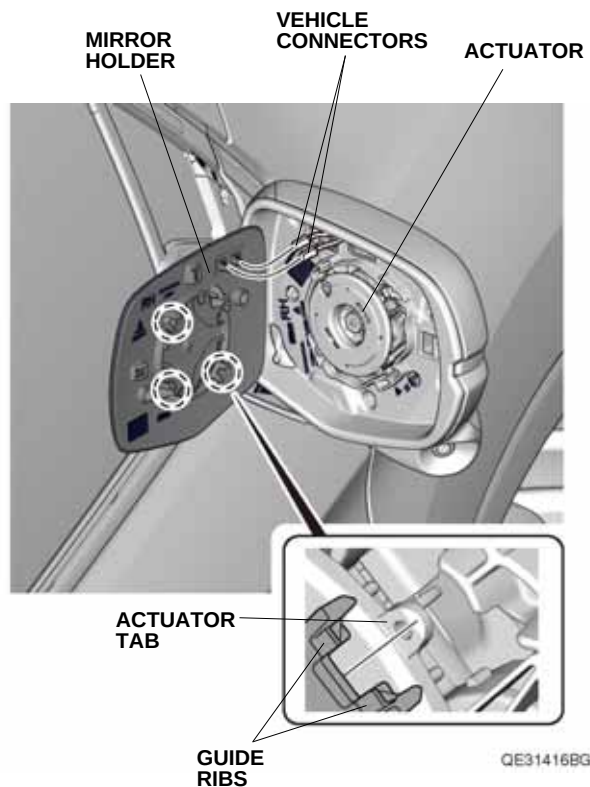
11. Install the door mirror housing on the door mirror bracket.



12. Install the door mirror visor with the TORX screws removed in step 4 and one hook.

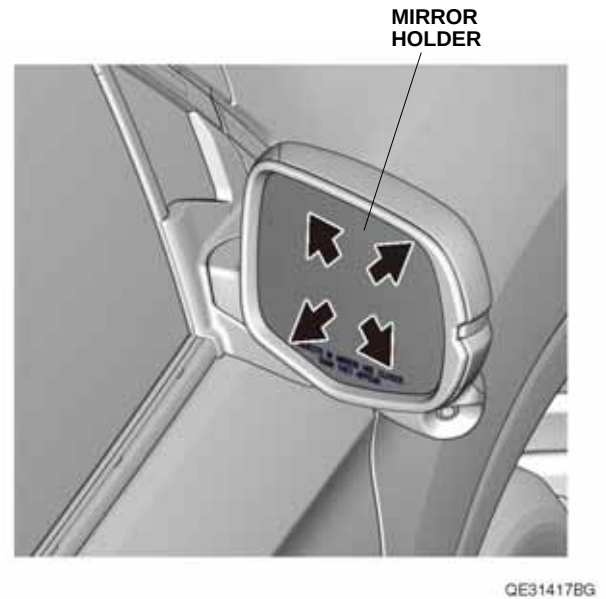


13. Plug the vehicle connectors into the mirror holder.



14. Align the guide ribs on the mirror holder so they line up on each side with the actuator tabs. Reinstall the mirror holder on the actuator.

15. Move the mirror holder in all directions to confirm it is installed securely.



16. Repeat steps 2 through 15 to install the left door mirror cover.
17. Connect the negative cable to the battery.
18. Install the front bulkhead cover and the intake air tube.
19. Press and hold the audio unit power button for 2 seconds to restore the audio and navi (if equipped) system functions.
20. Set the clock on vehicles without navigation.
21. If necessary, restore the systems back to normal operation as described in the service information.
