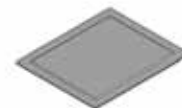

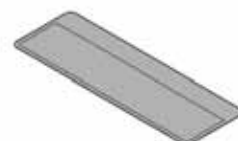

### INSTALLATION

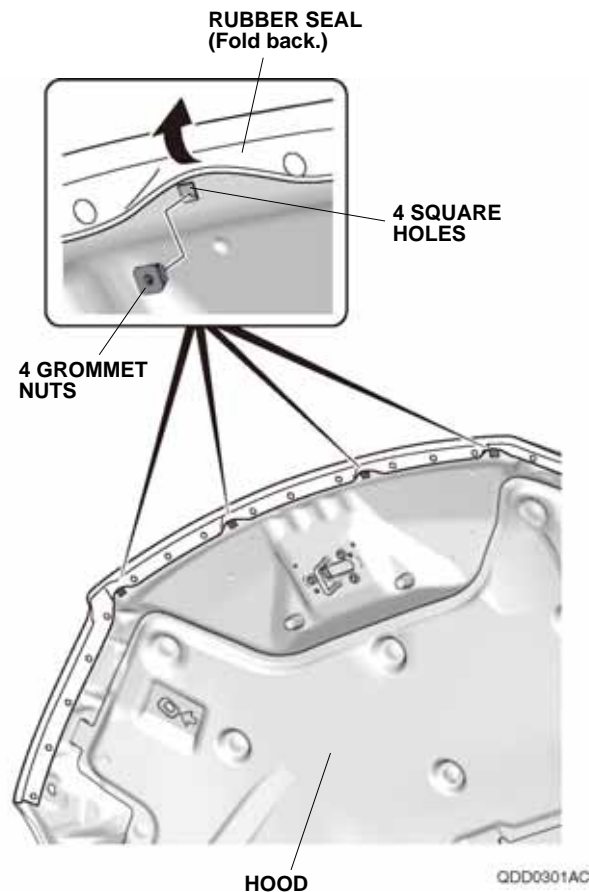
**Customer Information:** The information in this installation instruction is intended for use only by skilled technicians who have the proper tools, equipment, and training to correctly and safely add equipment to your vehicle. These procedures should not be attempted by “do-it-yourselfers.”

#### NOTE:

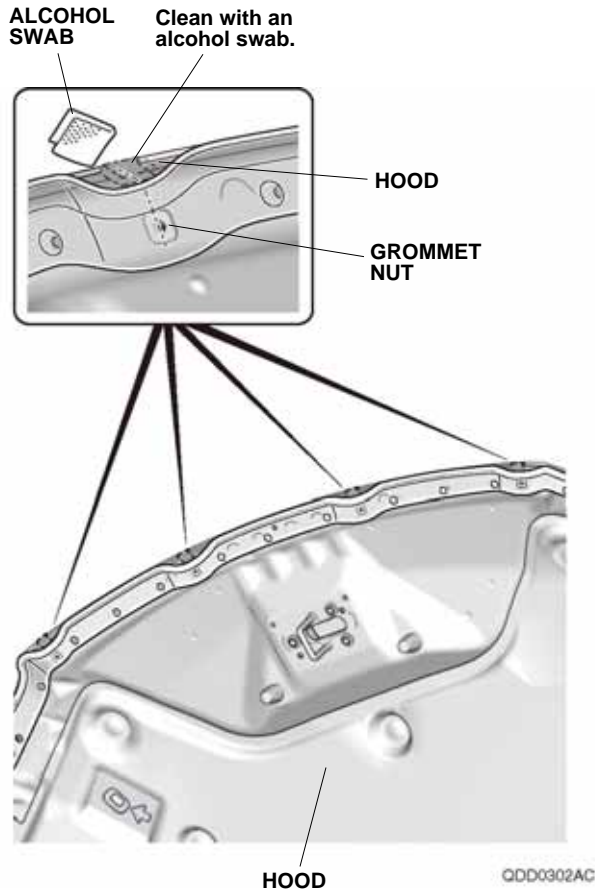
- Be careful not to damage the paint finish.
- This kit should be installed only if the ambient air temperature is 15°C (60°F) or above.
- To allow the adhesive to cure, do not wash the vehicle for 24 hours. Please advise the customer.

### Installing the Hood Air Deflector

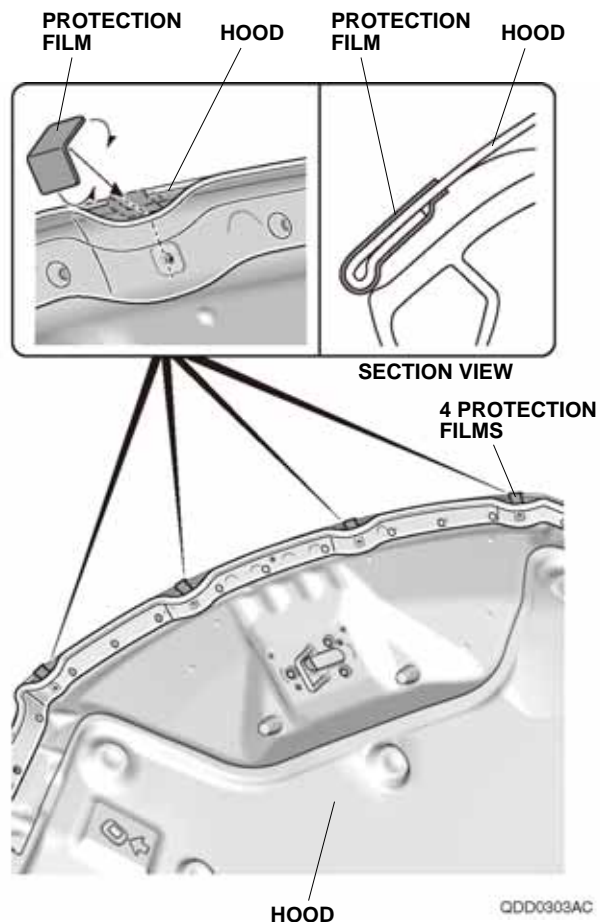
1. Open the hood. Fold back the rubber seal, and locate the four square holes on the inside of the hood. Push one grommet nut into each square hole in the hood.



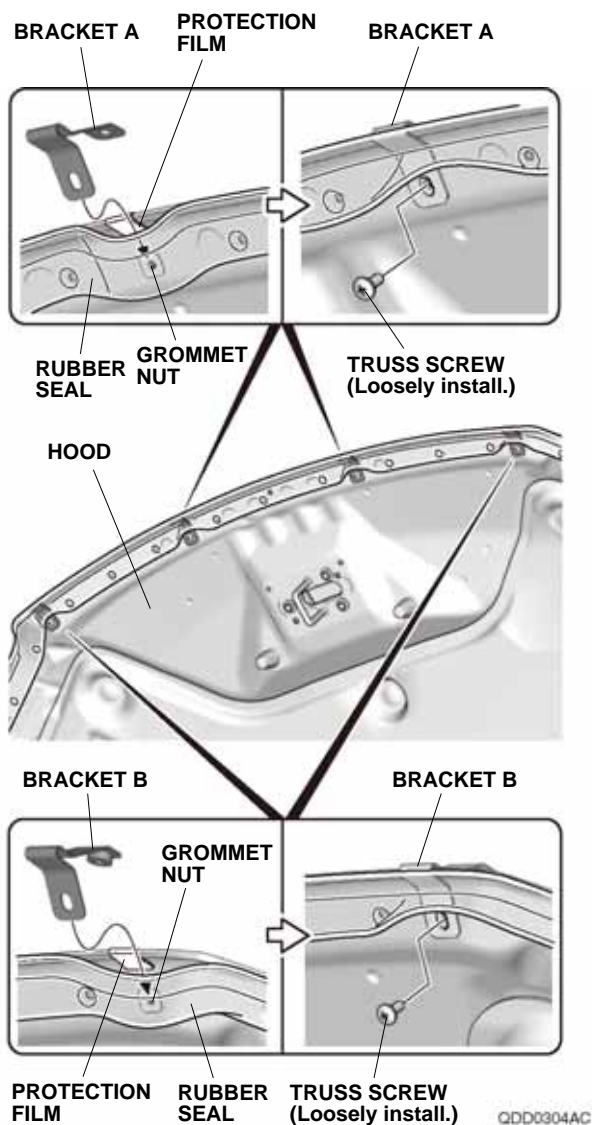
2. Fold back the rubber seal, and using an alcohol swab, clean the areas of the hood where the two brackets A and the two brackets B will mount.



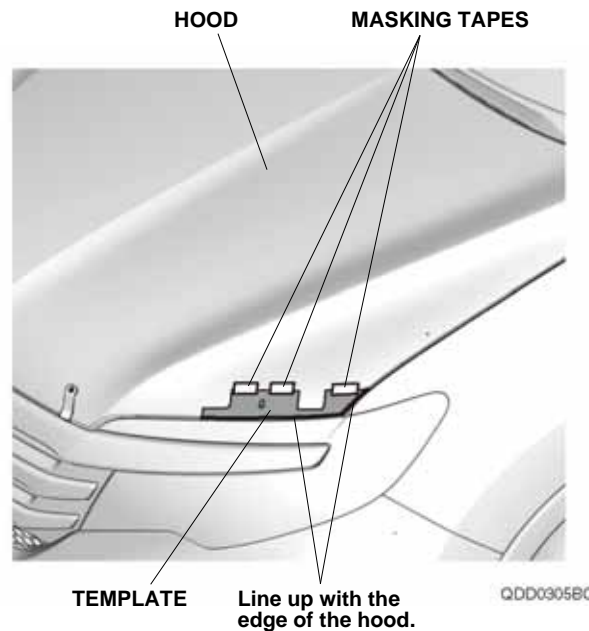
3. Remove the four adhesive backings from the four protection films, and attach them to the front of the hood area where the two brackets A and the two brackets B will mount.



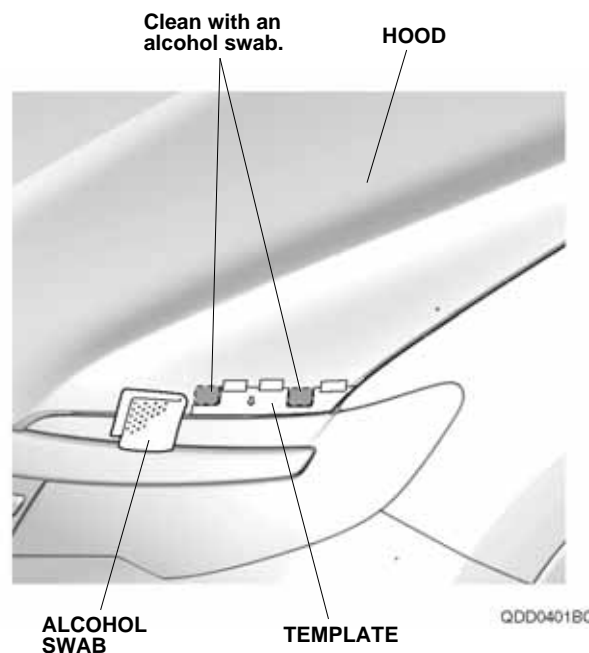
4. Slide the two brackets A and the two brackets B over the lip of the hood, and line up with the holes in the four grommet nuts. Loosely install a truss screw through each bracket.



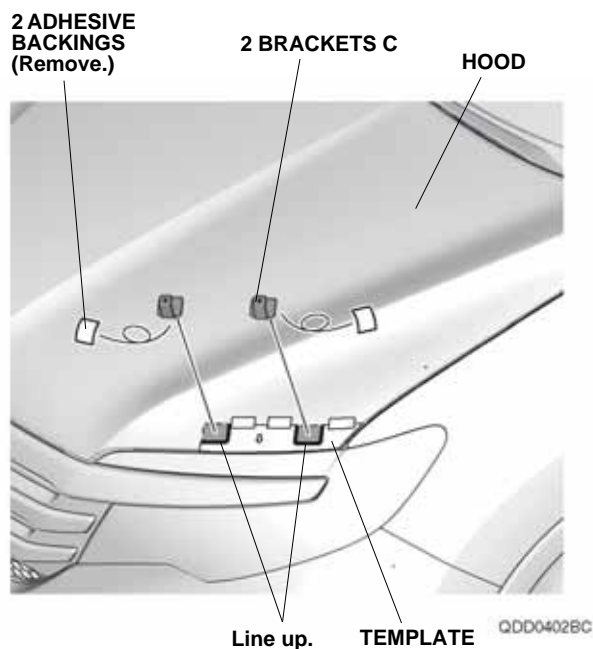
5. Close the hood. Attach the template to the front edge of the hood on the driver's side of the vehicle as shown. Secure the template to the hood with strips of masking tape.



6. Using an alcohol swab, clean the areas where the two brackets C will mount.

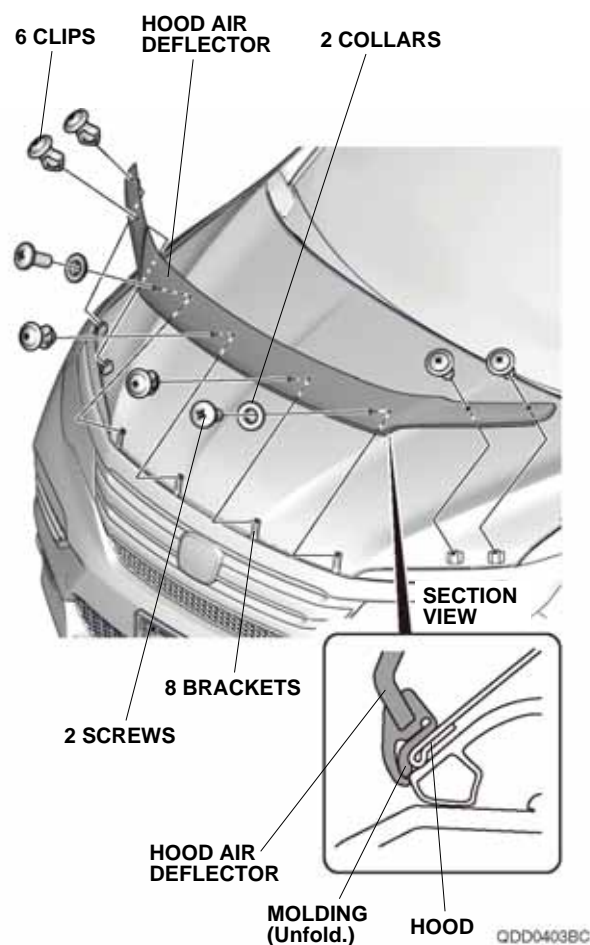


7. Remove the two adhesive backings from the two brackets C, and line up with the template secured in step 5. Remove the template.

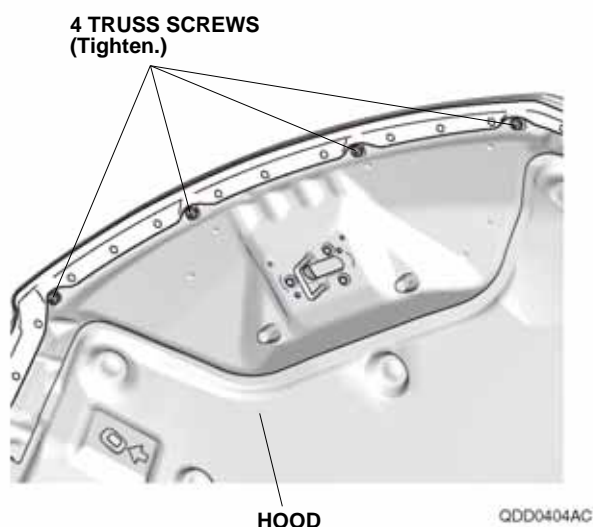


8. Turn the template over and repeat steps 5 through 7 to install the other two brackets C on the right side of the vehicle.

9. Position the hood air deflector on the hood. Line up the holes in the hood air deflector with the holes in the eight brackets. Install the hood air deflector to the eight brackets with two screws, two collars and six clips. Tighten the two screws securely.



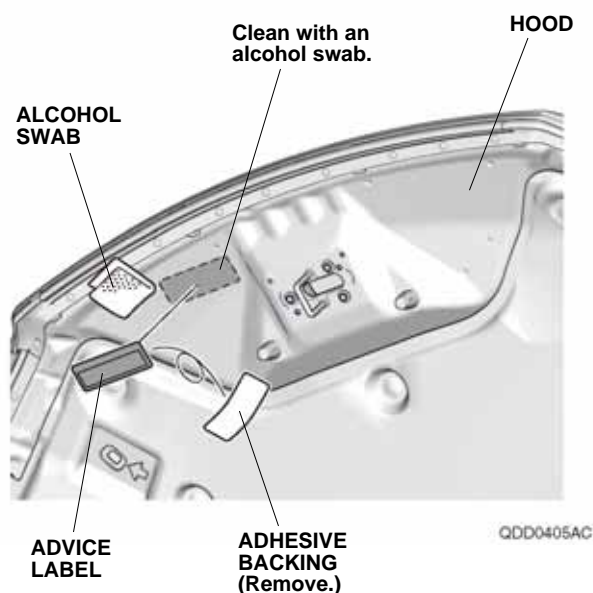
10. Open the hood. Tighten the four truss screws loosely installed in step 4.



## CARE OF THE HOOD AIR DEFLECTOR

- To avoid damaging the surface, never use ammonia-based cleaners or solvents to clean the hood air deflector.
- Clean with a solution of mild dishwashing soap and water using a soft cloth or chamois.
- To remove fine scratches and restore the original luster, use Meguiar's Mirror Glaze plastic cleaner and polish or an equivalent high-quality plastic cleaner.

11. Using an alcohol swab, clean inside the hood where the advice label will attach.



12. Remove the adhesive backing from the advice label, and attach the advice label to the hood as shown.  
NOTE: Do not attach the advice label over any other vehicle label.
