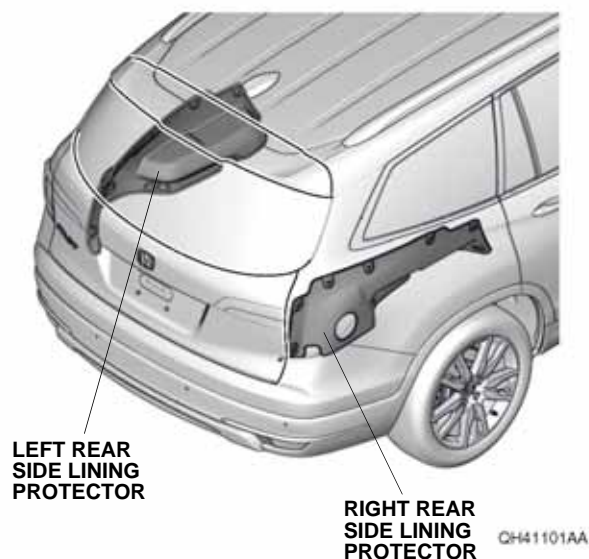

### Illustration of the Rear Side Lining Protectors on the Vehicle



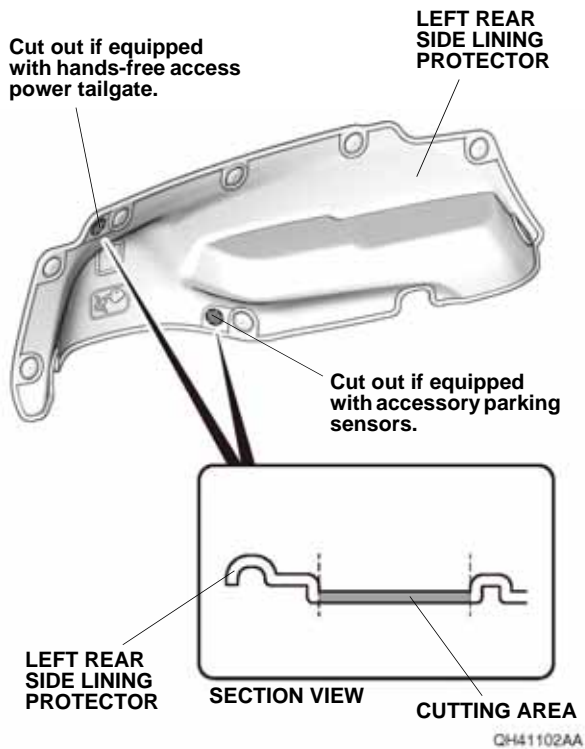
### INSTALLATION

NOTE: Be careful not to damage the body.

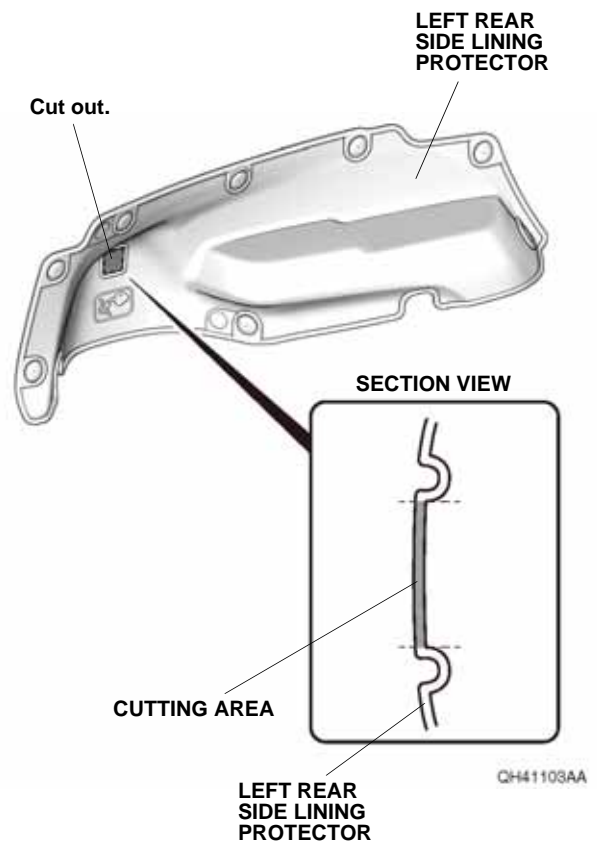
## With accessory parking sensors or hands-free access power tailgate

1. If the vehicle is equipped with parking sensors or hands-free access, cut out the left rear side lining protector as shown.



## With accessory power socket

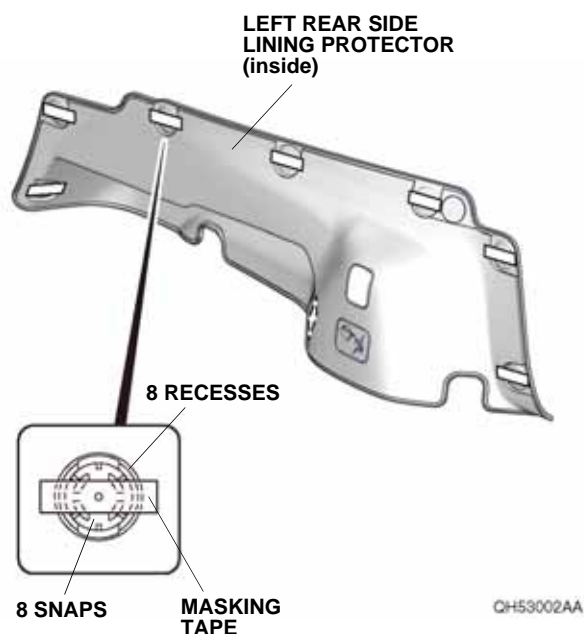
2. If the vehicle is equipped with accessory power socket, cut out the left rear side lining protector as shown.



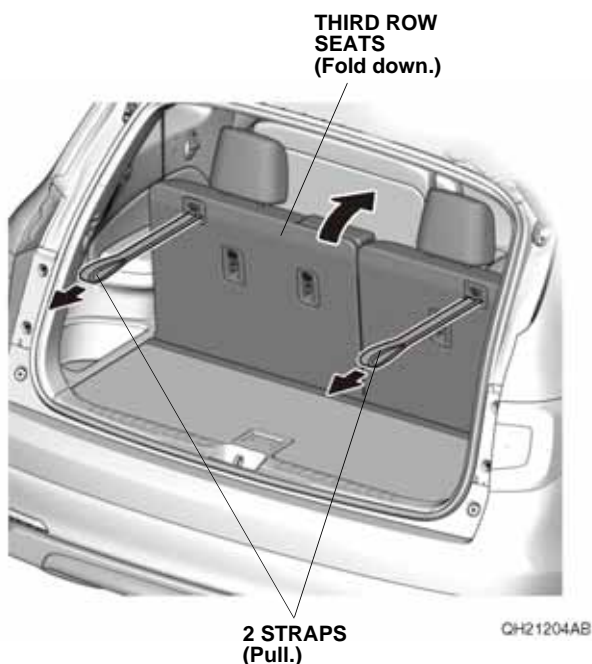
## Installing the Rear Side Lining Protectors

- Center the snaps with the recesses in the left and right rear side lining protectors. Apply masking tape to the back surfaces to keep them in place during installation.

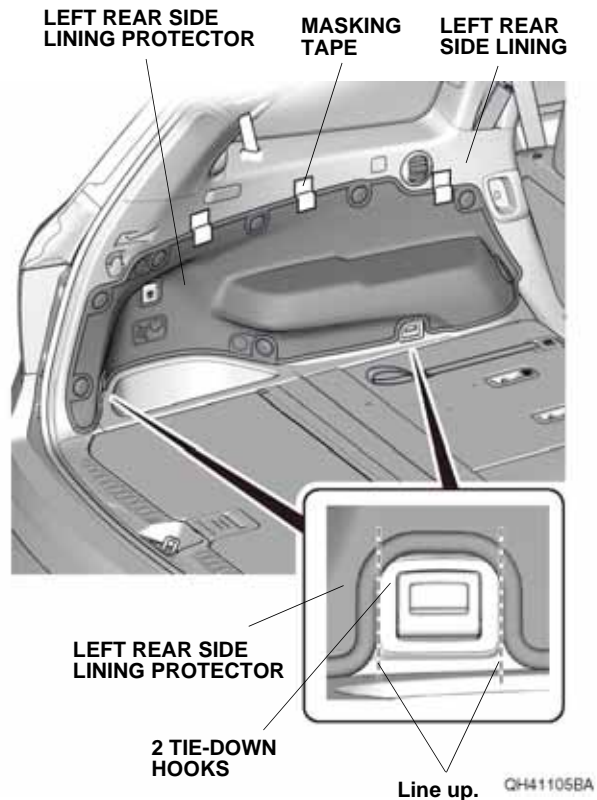
NOTE: Follow the same procedure for the differently shaped right rear side lining protector.



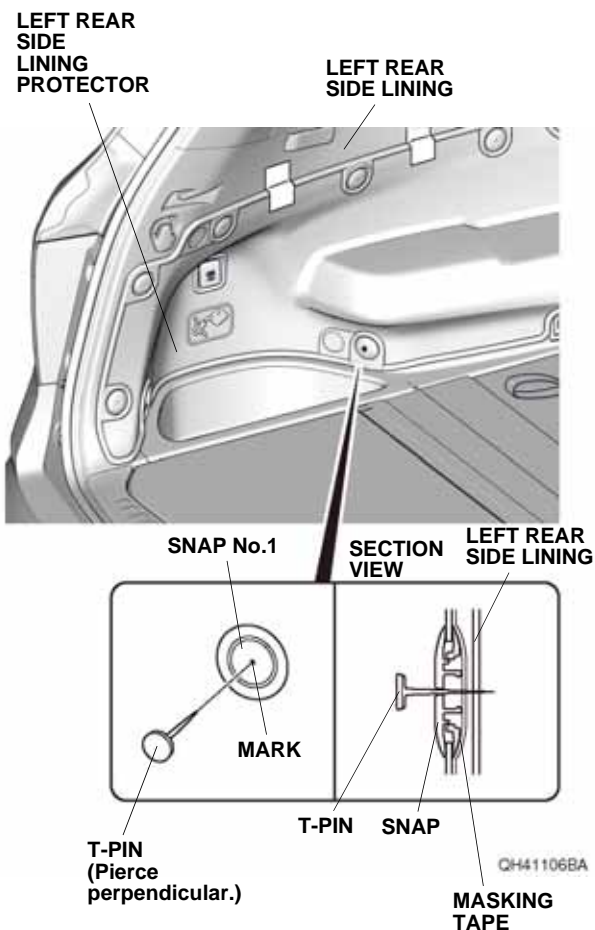
- Pull each strap, and fold down the third row seats.



- Line up the left rear side lining protector, temporarily attach it to the left rear side lining with masking tape as shown.



6. Using a T-pin, pierce the left rear side lining through the hole in the snap No.1 as shown. Remove the masking tape from this snap attached in step 3.  
NOTE: Make sure to pierce the left rear side lining perpendicular. Do not remove the masking tape from the other snaps at this time.



7. Remove the left rear side lining protector.

8. While wearing eye protection, drill the pierced mark in step 6 to 3 mm.

NOTE:

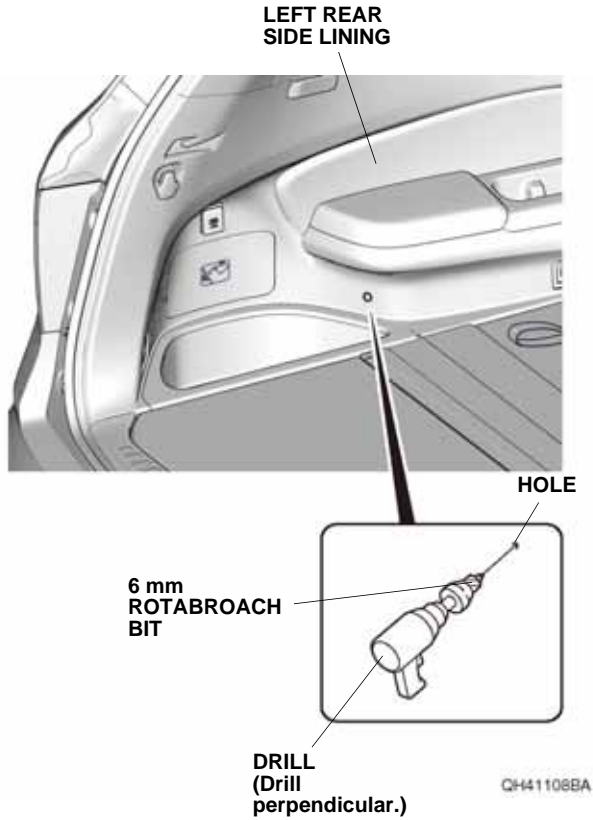
- Wrap masking tape around a 3 mm drill bit, 10 mm (0.39 in.) away from the tip, or use a drill stop.
- Make sure to drill perpendicular to the left rear side lining.



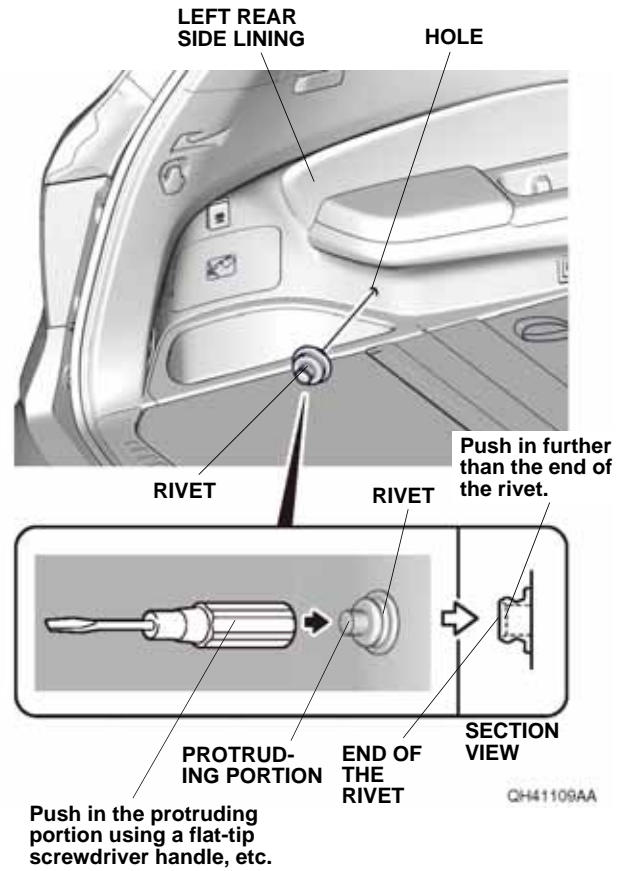
9. While wearing eye protection, enlarge the drilled hole in step 8 to 6 mm. Drill with a 6 mm Rotabroach bit.

NOTE:

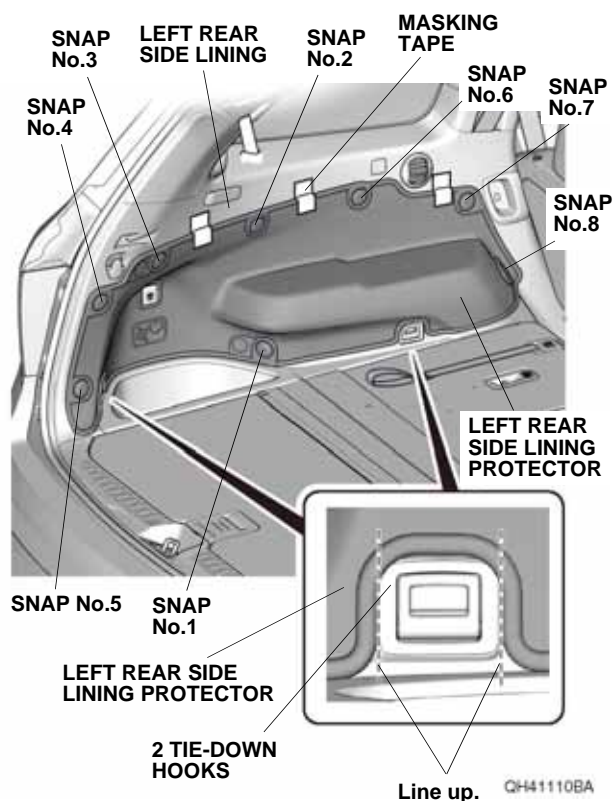
- Make sure to drill perpendicular to the left rear side lining.



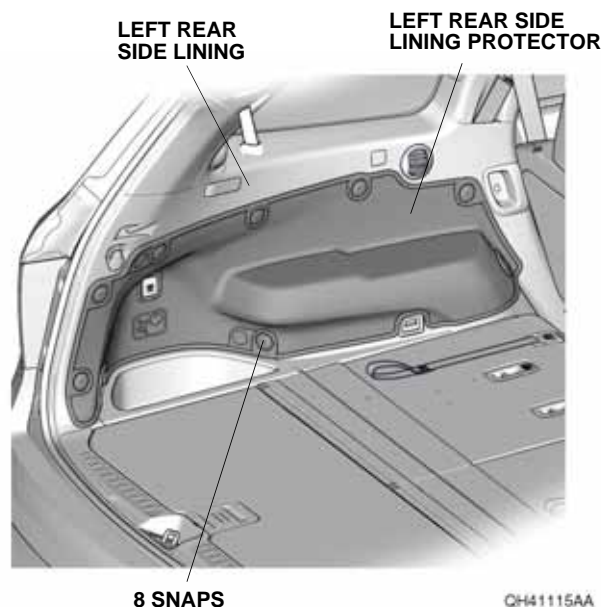
10. Install one rivet into the hole on the left rear side lining as shown.



11. Line up the left rear side lining protector, and temporarily attach it to the left rear side lining with the snap No.1 and masking tape as shown.



12. Repeat steps 6 through 10 for each of the remaining snaps, follow the pattern shown.
13. Fit the left rear side lining protector, and secure it to the left rear side lining with eight snaps.



14. Repeat steps 5 through 13 on the right side of the vehicle.
