

#### Procedure and Location Icons

Wear eye protection.



Wear heavy gloves.



Use an assistant.



Place the part on a blanket.



Work perpendicular.



Remove any burrs.



Use touch-up paint and allow to dry.



Tighten to the specified torque.



Apply firm pressure while rolling, especially at the ends, to set the adhesive.



Press firmly.



Clean with isopropyl alcohol.



Return the original part to the customer. (Do not use.)

### Wire Harness Routing Precautions



Do not secure the accessory harness and SRS harness together. (except for instruction cases).



Push the connectors and terminals together until they lock.



Do not pull the harness to unplug the connectors.



Install removed connectors in their original location.



Do not pull the harness.



Secure the accessory harness as shown.





Do not pinch the harness.



Cut off the excess wire tie.

#### Safety: General

- Observe all safety notes and precautions described in the service information, in addition to those described in this Installation Instruction. Be extremely careful for your safety and safety of others.
- Be careful not to damage the vehicle or the parts.
- Be extremely careful when handling retaining tabs and clips.
- Note the locations of the parts before removing them so they can be properly installed in their original positions.
- The illustrations may differ slightly from the actual accessory.


· Always disconnect the negative cable from the battery before beginning work.


#### Safety: Accessory

- Always use the parts and tools specified in the installation instructions.
- · Do not install the accessory on a dirty surface or in direct sunlight.
- Make sure the ambient air temperature is 60°F (15°C) or above when installing accessories that use a bonding material.
- When pressing the accessory firmly with the palm of your hand, be careful not to damage it or the vehicle.
- When applying adhesive material, make sure it is lined up properly before attaching. Once the adhesive material touches the surface, do not try to remove it. If you do, you could damage the part before the adhesive releases.
- Not to wash the vehicle for 24 hours to allow the adhesive to cure.

### **INSTALLATION**

Using isopropyl alcohol and a shop towel, thoroughly clean the surface where the accessory adhesive will attach.

#### NOTE

- Always use isopropyl alcohol where you see this symbol.
- Do not pour isopropyl alcohol directly on the vehicle surface.
- Let the isopropyl alcohol completely evaporate before attaching the adhesive material.






#### **NOTICE**

- Install in the order shown.
- Check for missing or displaced seat collars between the seat-back hooks and the body.
- Tighten the rear seat mounting bolts by hand first, then tighten them to the specified torque.
- 96. Check that all parts are installed and properly routed.

#### NOTE

- Check that all harnesses are not pulled and not pinched.
- Make sure all clamps and wire ties are securely installed.

- 97. Install all removed parts except for the front bulkhead cover and intake air tube.
- 98. Connect the negative cable to the battery.



- 99. Install the front bulkhead cover and intake air tube.
- 100. Make sure the accessory operates as described in the Accessory User's Information Manual.
- 101. Make sure all accessories and systems operate properly.
- 102. If necessary, restore the systems back to normal operation as described in the service information.
- 103. Press and hold the audio unit power button for 2 seconds to restore the audio and navi (if equipped) system functions.
- 104. Make sure your customer receives the Accessory User's Information Manual.

#### **Adjust the Volume Control**

#### NOTE

- The factory setting is maximum volume.
- After confirming the operation, turn the volume control knob to the appropriate level, using a small flat-tip screwdriver.
- Do not force the adjuster as it could damage the unit.
