



#### Procedure and Location Icons

Wear eye protection.



Wear heavy gloves.



Use an assistant.



Place the part on a blanket.



Work perpendicular.



Remove any burrs.



Use touch-up paint and allow to dry.



Tighten to the specified torque.



Apply firm pressure while rolling, especially at the ends, to set the adhesive.



Press firmly.



Clean with isopropyl alcohol.



Return the original part to the customer. (Do not reuse.)

### Safety: General


- Observe all safety notes and precautions described in the service information, in addition to those described in this Installation Instruction. Be extremely careful for your safety and safety of others.
- Be careful not to damage the vehicle or the parts.
- · Be extremely careful when handling retaining tabs and clips.
- Note the locations of the parts before removing them so they can be properly installed in their original positions.
- · The illustrations may differ slightly from the actual accessory.

### Safety: Accessory

- Always use the parts and tools specified in the installation instructions.
- Do not install the accessory on a dirty surface or in direct sunlight.
- Make sure the ambient air temperature is 60°F (15°C) or above when installing accessories that use adhesive material.
- When pressing the accessory firmly with the palm of your hand, be careful not to damage it or the vehicle.
- When applying adhesive material, make sure it is lined up properly before attaching. Once the adhesive material touches the surface, do not try to remove it. If you do, you could damage the part.
- Do not wash the vehicle for 24 hours to allow the adhesive to cure.




- 1. Open the trunk lid.
- 2. Remove the trunk lid trim panel.






Close the trunk lid.

4. Secure the template A and template B.



5. Mark the trunk lid.




- 6. Remove the template A and template B.
- 7. Mark the trunk lid.


Set the center punch to the minimum setting.




8. Flip the template A, and repeat the same procedures on the other side.




9. Drill the trunk lid.



#### 13. Remove the burrs.

#### **NOTE**

To ensure proper clip engagement, be sure to remove any metal shavings or burrs.






#### 14. Clean the attaching area.

#### NOTE

- · Any oil or dirt remaining on the trunk lid will affect the performance of the adhesive tape, which could cause gaps or spoiler lifting.
- Allow to dry thoroughly.



#### 15. Install the seals.




#### 16. Install the grommets.

#### NOTE


To confirm clip engagement, listen for the "click" sound during installation.



17. Install the special bolts and pins.




18. Temporarily attach the tabs.



19. Install the trunk spoiler.


#### NOTE

- · Do not apply excessive pressure.
- To confirm the pin engagement, listen for a click sound during installation. Using your hands, lift up on the pin area of the spoiler to confirm the pins are fully engaged.


#### 20. Line up the trunk spoiler.


- Secure in the order shown.
- Check the position of the double-sided adhesive tapes and make sure to press firmly.






- 23. Open the trunk lid.

25. Release the left seat-back release lever (if equipped) and right seat-back release lever.




26. Release the trunk lid support strut.
