



Illustration of the Wireless Charger Installed in the Vehicle




Customer Information: The information in this installation instruction is intended for use only by skilled technicians who have the proper tools, equipment, and training to correctly and safely add equipment to your vehicle. These procedures should not be attempted by "do-it-yourselfers."

1. Disconnect the negative cable from the battery.

2. Remove the driver's dashboard lower cover, unplug the vehicle connectors, and aspirator hose.




3. Remove the left console armrest.





- Insert the key into the shift lock release slot, and move the shift lever knob to the D position.




49. Reinstall the switch panel, the lower tray mat, and the console panel.



- 50. Plug the wireless charger harness 7-pin connector into the wireless charger unit, and Install the wireless charger unit to the console panel with two self-tapping screws and two clips.
- 51. Install the upper tray mat to the console panel with five clips and two retaining tabs.




52. Plug the 20A blade fuse into the fuse box. If the 20A fuse is already plugged, do not plug the 20A blade fuse.



If the option fuse label is already attached on the driver's kick panel, go to step 55; otherwise continue with step 53.

53. Using isopropyl alcohol on a shop towel, thoroughly clean the area where the fuse label will attach.



- 54. Attach the fuse label on the driver's kick panel.
- 55. Check that all wire harnesses are routed properly and all connectors are plugged in.
- 56. Install all removed parts.
- 57. Connect the negative cable to the battery.
- 58. Press and hold the audio unit power button for 2 seconds to restore the audio and navi (if equipped) system functions.
- 59. Set the clock on vehicles without navigation.
- 60. If necessary, restore the systems back to normal operation as described in the service information.

61. Check that the wireless charger works properly as described in the accessory user's information manual.
