



Illustration of the Black Emblems Installed on the Vehicle






INSTALLATION

Customer Information: The information in this installation instruction is intended for use only by skilled technicians who have the proper tools, equipment, and training to correctly and safely add equipment to your vehicle. These procedures should not be attempted by "do-it-yourselfers."


NOTE:

- Be careful not to damage the body paint finish.
- This kit should be installed only if the ambient air temperature is 60°F (15°C) or above.
- To allow the adhesive to cure, do not wash the vehicle for 24 hours. Make sure the your customer is aware of this.
- 1. Disconnect the negative cable from the battery, then wait at least 3 minutes before starting work.
- 2. Wrap a shop towel around the hood latch lever.




3. Remove the front bulkhead cover.




4. Remove the three self-tapping screws, one clip, and three clips (short) from the left front wheel arch protector as shown.



5. Remove the left front wheel arch protector as shown.




- 6. Repeat steps 4 and 5 on the right side of the vehicle.
- 7. Remove the front bumper:
 - Apply masking tape on each side as shown.




Remove the two self-tapping screws and 10 clips as shown.



• With the help of an assistant, release the seven retaining tabs on each side.




- With the help of an assistant, remove the front bumper, and unplug the vehicle connectors (if equipped).
- Place the front bumper on a blanket.




14. Using an alcohol wipe, thoroughly clean the front grille where the front H emblem will attach.


15. Remove the adhesive backings from the front H emblem. Install the front H emblem to the front grille as shown.

NOTE: Check the orientation of the push nut.




16. Using the palm of your hand, firmly press the front H emblem against the front grille.



Remove the vehicle rear H emblem from the tailgate trim.




19. Using an alcohol wipe, thoroughly clean the tailgate trim where the rear H emblem will attach.


20. Remove the adhesive backings from the rear H emblem. Install the rear H emblem to the tailgate trim as shown.

NOTE: Check the orientation of the push nut.



21. Using the palm of your hand, firmly press the rear H emblem against the tailgate trim.

22. Remove the position film from the CR-V emblem, then remove the CR-V emblem from the guide form.



23. Install the guide form to the vehicle CR-V emblem on the tailgate.







 - Make sure to thoroughly remove the adhesive tape from the vehicle body.






28. Using an alcohol wipe, thoroughly clean the tailgate where the CR-V emblem will attach.

30. Remove the guide form and using the palm of your hand, firmly press the CR-V emblem against the tailgate.






- 33. Using a piece of string, remove the vehicle AWD emblem by cutting along the outer edges as shown. NOTE:
 - Do not damage the vehicle body when removing the vehicle AWD emblem with the string.
 - Make sure to thoroughly remove the adhesive tape from the vehicle body.



34. Using an alcohol wipe, thoroughly clean the tailgate where the AWD emblem will attach.



35. Remove the adhesive backing from the AWD emblem. Line up the AWD emblem with the masking tape, and attach the AWD emblem to the tailgate.



- 36. Using the palm of your hand, firmly press the AWD emblem against the tailgate.
- 37. Remove the masking tape from the tailgate.

- 38. With the help of an assistant, install the front bumper.
- 39. Check that all wire harnesses are routed properly and all connectors are plugged in.
- 40. Install all removed parts.
- 41. Connect the negative cable to the battery.
- 42. Press and hold the audio unit power button for 2 seconds to restore the audio and navi (if equipped) system functions.
- 43. Set the clock on vehicles without navigation.
- 44. If necessary, restore the systems back to normal operation as described in the service information.
