


Illustration of the Front Grille Trims on the Vehicle



- 1. Disconnect the negative cable from the battery.
- 2. Wrap a shop towel around the hood latch lever.




3. Remove the front bulkhead cover.



4. Remove the three self-tapping screws, one clip, and three clips (short) from the left front wheel arch protector as shown.




5. Remove the left front wheel arch protector as shown.




- 6. Repeat steps 4 and 5 on the right side of the vehicle.
- 7. Remove the front bumper:

• Apply masking tape on each side as shown.




• Remove the two self-tapping screws and 10 clips as shown.




• With the help of an assistant, release the seven retaining tabs on each side.




- With the help of an assistant, remove the front bumper, and unplug the vehicle connectors (if equipped).
- Place the front bumper on a blanket.



8. Remove the left front grille trim as shown.



9. Install the new left front grille trim.



- 10. Repeat steps 8 and 9 on the right side of vehicle.
- 11. Check that all wire harnesses are routed properly and all connectors are plugged in.
- 12. Install all removed parts.
- 13. Connect the negative cable to the battery.
- 14. Press and hold the audio unit power button for 2 seconds to restore the audio and navi (if equipped) system functions.
- 15. Set the clock on vehicles without navigation.
- 16. If necessary, restore the systems back to normal operation as described in the service information.
