You **CAN** be **HURT** if you don't follow instructions.

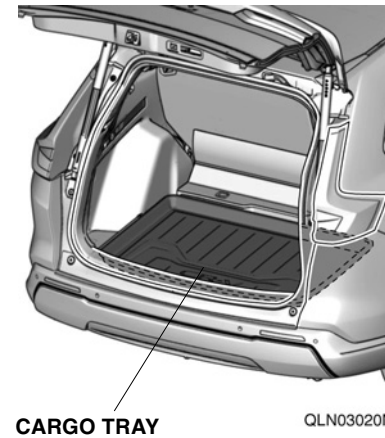
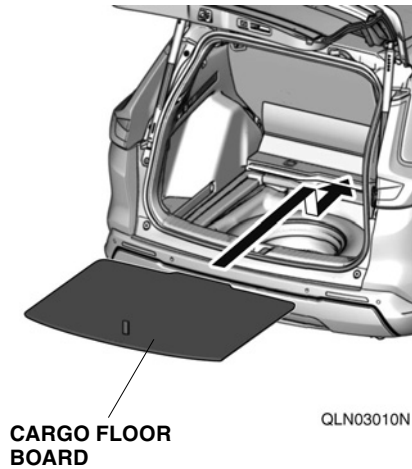

Installation

1. Remove the cargo floor board, and place it into the lower position.
2. Place the cargo tray on the cargo floor board.



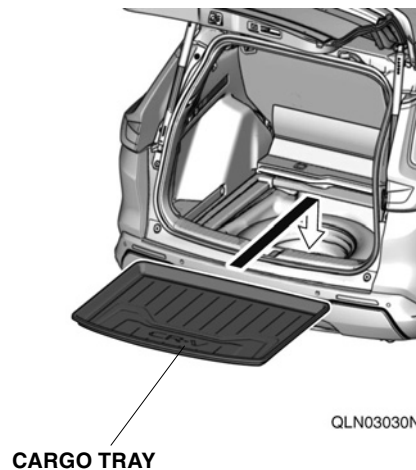

Storing the Cargo Tray

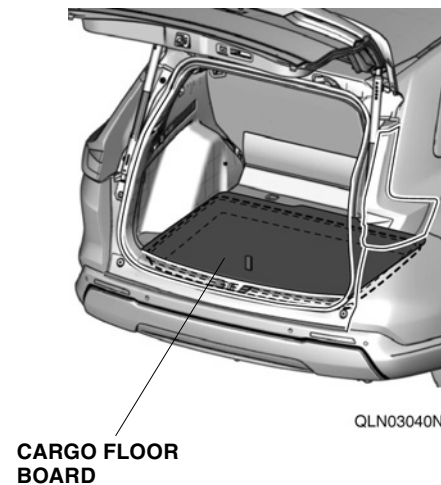
NOTICE

Do not place articles on the cargo tray in the storing position.

1. Remove the cargo floor board. Place the cargo tray in the cargo area.



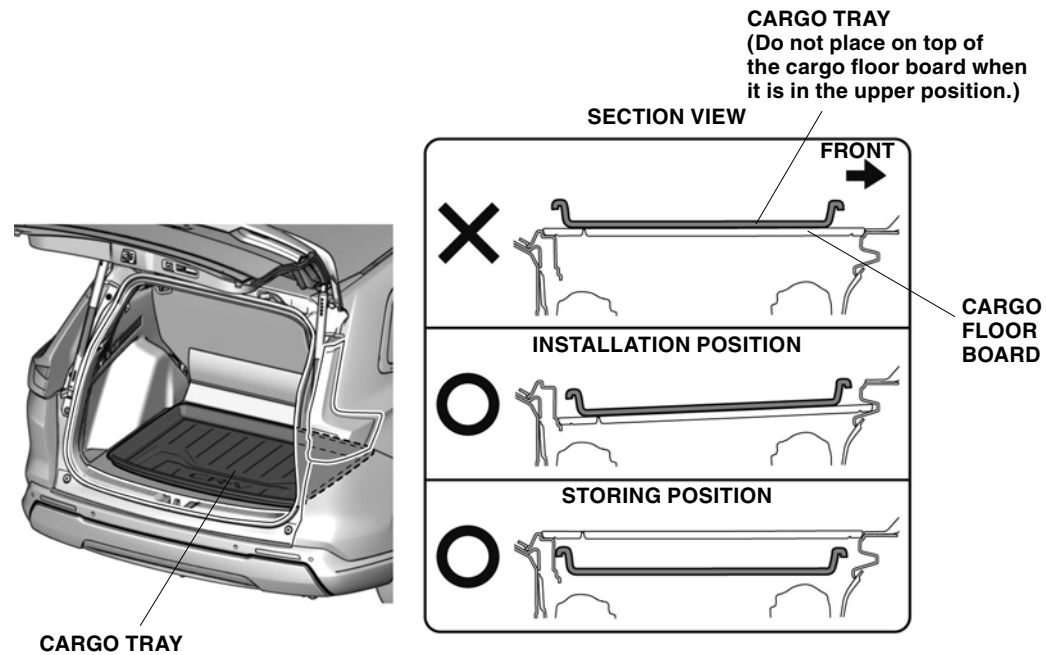
2. Reinstall the cargo floor board into the upper position over the cargo tray.

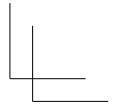
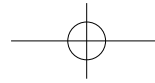
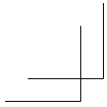
Information

To prevent the cargo tray from sliding, do not place the cargo tray on top of the cargo floor board when it is in the upper position.

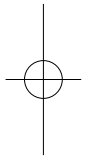
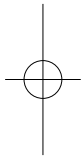
