

Press firmly.




Clean with isopropyl alcohol.



Return the original part to the customer. (Do not reuse.)


Wire Harness Routing Precaution



Do not secure the accessory harness to the SRS harness. (except for instruction cases.)



Push the connectors and terminals together until they lock.



Do not pull the harness to unplug the connectors.



Install removed connectors in their original location.



Do not pull the harness.




Secure the accessory harness as shown.





Do not pinch the harness.



Cut off the excess wire tie.

Safety: General

- Observe all safety notes and precautions described in the service information, in addition to those described in this Installation Instruction. Be extremely careful for your safety and safety of others.
- · Be careful not to damage the vehicle or the parts.
- Be extremely careful when handling retaining tabs and clips.
- Note the locations of the parts before removing them so they can be properly installed in their original positions.
- · The illustrations may differ slightly from the actual accessory.

Safety: Electric Parts

Always disconnect the negative cable from the battery before beginning work.


Safety: Accessory

- Always use the parts and tools specified in the installation instructions.
- · Do not install the accessory on a dirty surface or in direct sunlight.
- Make sure the ambient air temperature is 60°F (15°C) or above when installing accessories that use adhesive material.
- When pressing the accessory firmly with the palm of your hand, be careful not to damage it or the vehicle.
- When applying adhesive material, make sure it is lined up properly before attaching. Once the adhesive material touches the surface, do not try to remove it. If you do, you could damage the part.
- Do not wash the vehicle for 24 hours to allow the adhesive to cure.



- 113. Make sure all accessories and systems operate properly.
- 114. If necessary, restore the systems back to normal operation as described in the service information.
- 115. Press and hold the audio unit power button for 2 seconds to restore the audio and navi (if equipped) system functions.
- 116. Provide rear bumper beam and six bolts (removed in step 27) to customer.
- 117. Give the Accessory User's Information Manual to the customer.



TRAILER HITCH

Install the ball mount to the trailer hitch using a hitch pin clip and hitch pin.

Whenever you remove the hitch pin clip, the hitch pin, and the ball mount, store them securely in the cargo area. Install the cover into the opening at the end of the trailer hitch.


When you reinstall the ball mount, store the cover in the cargo area.



After the first 600 miles (1,000 km) of towing, have your Honda Dealer check the tightness of the trailer hitch bolts.

MARNING

If removing trailer hitch, replace with appropriate rear bumper beam. Failure to replace bumper beam will reduce crashworthiness and increase likelihood of severe injury or death.
