
Of course, it is not practical or possible to warn you about all the hazards associated with operating or maintaining your vehicle. You must use your own good judgment.


For your safety and safety of others, pay special attention to all warning symbols. Failure to follow the warnings contained in this manual can result in damage to your vehicle, serious injury, or death.





Rear USB Charger Use and Functions

- Plug-in your device's USB connector into the USB port.
- The charger can be used with the ENGINE START/STOP button (POWER button) in the ON mode or the ACCESSORY mode.
- The USB ports (3.0A) are only for charging devices.

Rear USB Charger Use and Functions

NOTICE

- The USB port can supply up to 3.0A of power. It does not output 3.0A unless requested by the device.
- For amperage details, read the operating manual of the device that needs to be charged.
- Under certain conditions, a device connected to the port may generate noise on the radio station you are listening to.
- These ports are only for charging devices. You cannot play music even if you have connected a music player to the port.
- Do not leave the USB device in the vehicle. Direct sunlight and high temperatures may damage it.
- Do not connect the USB device using a hub.
- Do not use a device such as a card reader or hard disk drive, as the device or your files may be damaged.
- We recommend backing up your data before using the device in your vehicle.
- Avoid using the USB charger for a long time in ACCESSORY mode. Doing so may drain the vehicle's battery.
