
Always disconnect the negative cable from the battery before beginning work.

### Safety: Accessory


- · Do not install the accessory on a dirty surface or in direct sunlight.
- Make sure the ambient air temperature is 60°F (15°C) or above when installing accessories that use adhesive material.
- When pressing the accessory firmly with the palm of your hand, be careful not to damage it or the vehicle.
- When applying adhesive material, make sure it is lined up properly before attaching. Once the adhesive material touches the surface, do not try to remove it. If you do, you could damage the part.
- · Do not wash the vehicle for 24 hours to allow the adhesive to cure.







### **INSTALLATION**

1. Disconnect the negative cable from the battery.


#### NOTE

- Follow the "12 Volt Battery Terminal Disconnection and Reconnection" described in the service information since the work differs depending on the vehicle.
- Take countermeasures to prevent from locking the tailgate.


