



Illustration of the Armrest Console Installed in the Vehicle







1. Disconnect the negative cable from the battery.


2. Open the glove box, push inward on the stops, and remove the glove box.

4. Remove the center lower cover, and unplug the vehicle connectors.




69. Install the armrest console to the center console with three washers, bracket B, and three bolts.

- 72. Check that all wire harnesses are routed properly and all connectors are plugged in.
- 73. Install all removed parts.
- 74. Connect the negative cable to the battery.
- 75. Press and hold the audio unit power button for 2 seconds to restore the audio and navi (if equipped) system functions.
- 76. Set the clock.
- 77. If necessary, restore the systems back to normal operation as described in the service information.
