



Illustration of the Black Emblems Installed on the Vehicle






INSTALLATION

Customer Information: The information in this installation instruction is intended for use only by skilled technicians who have the proper tools, equipment, and training to correctly and safely add equipment to your vehicle. These procedures should not be attempted by "do-it-yourselfers."


NOTE:

- · Be careful not to damage the body paint finish.
- This kit should be installed only if the ambient air temperature is 60°F (15°C) or above.
- To allow the adhesive to cure, do not wash the vehicle for 24 hours. Make sure the your customer is aware of this.
- 1. Disconnect the negative cable from the battery.

- 2. Remove the front bumper:
 - Wrap a shop towel around the lever.
 - Apply masking tape as shown.






Remove the 12 clips.







 Remove the two self-tapping screws and four clips on each side.



Remove the front wheel arch protector on each side.




• Remove the self-tapping screw on each side.





- Place the front bumper on a blanket.



NOTE: Check the orientation of the push nuts.




8. Using the palm of your hand, firmly press the front H emblem against the front grille.

9. Using a piece of string, remove the vehicle rear H emblem by cutting along the outer edges as shown.


NOTE:

- Make sure to thoroughly remove the adhesive tape from the rear license trim.



 - Make sure to thoroughly remove the adhesive tape from the vehicle body.



27. Using an alcohol wipe, thoroughly clean the tailgate where the AWD emblem will attach.




28. Remove the adhesive backing from the AWD emblem. Line up the AWD emblem with the masking tape, and attach the AWD emblem to the tailgate.



- Using the palm of your hand, firmly press the AWD emblem against the tailgate.
- 30. Remove the masking tape from the tailgate.




38. Using an alcohol wipe, thoroughly clean the tailgate where the SPORT emblem will attach.

40. Remove the guide form and using the palm of your hand, firmly press the SPORT emblem against the tailgate.



41. Remove the masking tape from the tailgate.

- 42. Check that all wire harnesses are routed properly and all connectors are plugged in.
- 43. Install all removed parts.
- 44. Connect the negative cable to the battery.
- 45. Press and hold the audio unit power button for 2 seconds to restore the audio and navi (if equipped) system functions.
- 46. Set the clock on vehicles without navigation.
- 47. If necessary, restore the systems back to normal operation as described in the service information.
