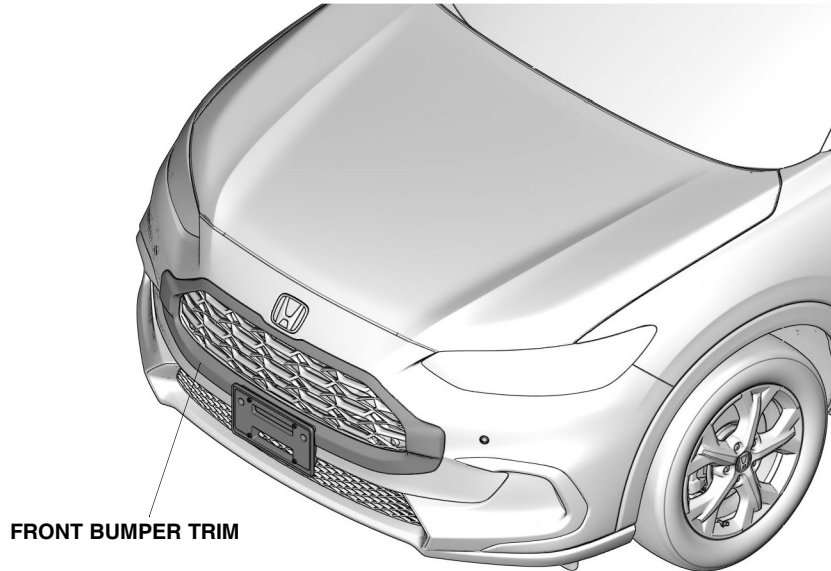

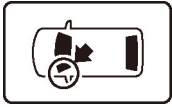

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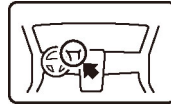
## Procedure and Location Icons

These icons indicate the work location and the worker's point of view.

Wear eye protection.



Wear heavy gloves.



Use an assistant.



Place the part on a blanket.



Work perpendicular.



Remove any burrs.



Use touch-up paint and allow to dry.



Tighten to the specified torque.



Apply firm pressure while rolling, especially at the ends, to set the adhesive.



Press firmly.

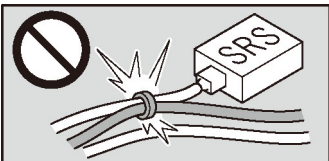


Clean with isopropyl alcohol.

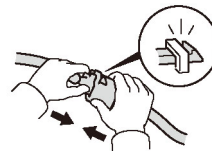


Return the original part to the customer.

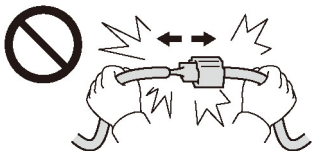
## Wire Harness Routing Precaution



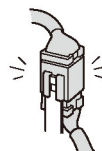
Do not secure the

cases.)



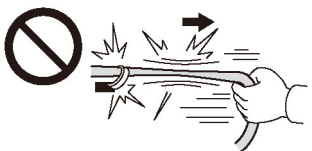
Push the connectors and

location.



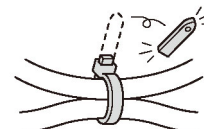
Do not pull the harness.

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## Safety: General

- Observe all safety notes and precautions described in the service information, in addition to those described in this Installation Instruction. Be extremely careful for your safety and the safety of others.
- Be careful not to damage the vehicle or the parts.
- Be extremely careful when handling retaining tabs and clips.
- Note the locations of the parts before removing them so they can be properly installed in their original positions.
- The illustrations may differ slightly from the actual accessory.








Always disconnect the negative cable from the battery before beginning work.

## Safety: Accessory

- Always use the parts and tools specified in the installation instructions.
- Do not install the accessory on a dirty surface or in direct sunlight.
- Make sure the ambient air temperature is 60°F (15°C) or above when installing accessories that use adhesive material.
- When pressing the accessory firmly with the palm of your hand, be careful not to damage it or the vehicle.
- When applying adhesive material, make sure it is lined up properly before attaching. Once the adhesive material touches the surface, do not try to remove it. If you do, you could damage the part.
- Do not wash the vehicle for 24 hours to allow the adhesive to cure.

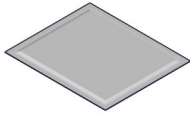

1. Disconnect the negative cable from the battery.

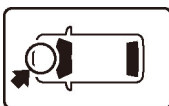


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2. Wrap a shop towel.

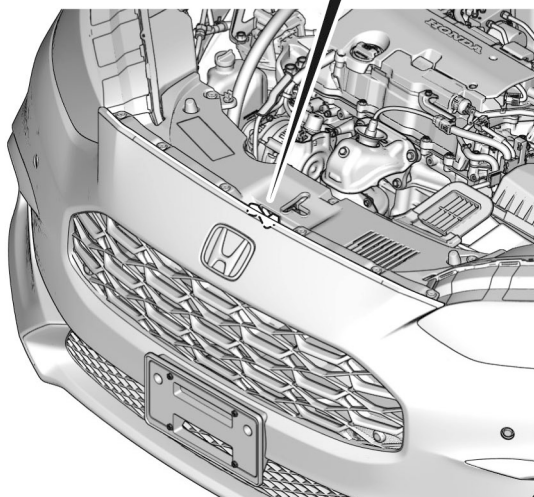
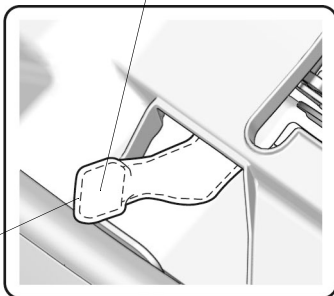

7. Attach masking tape to protect the vehicle.

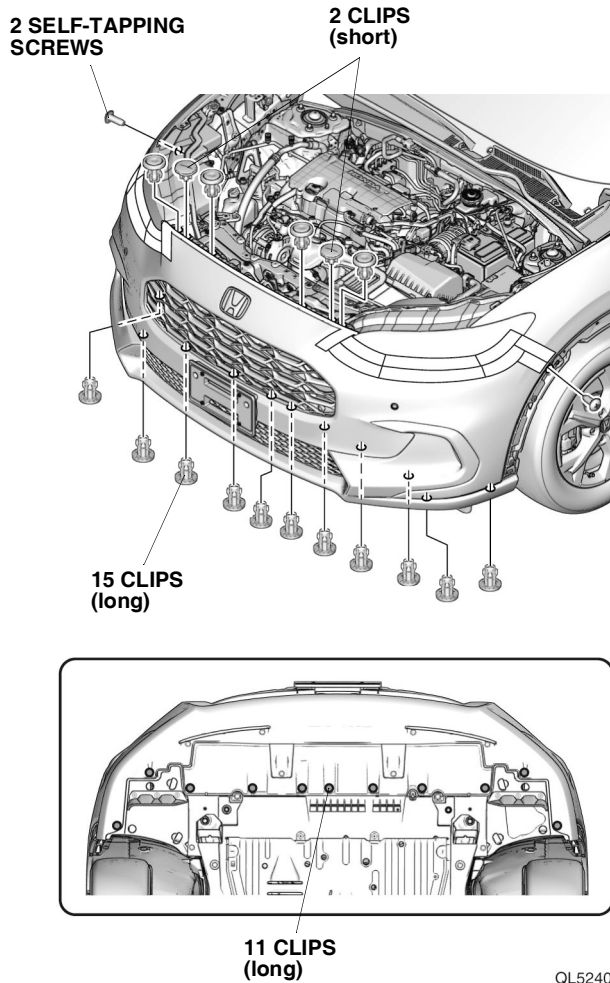

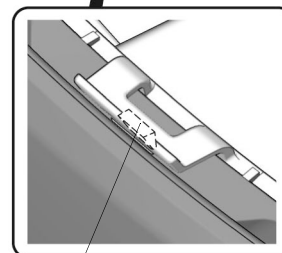
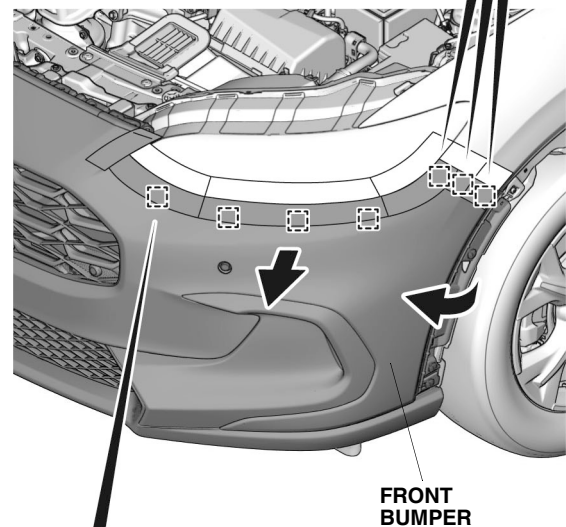
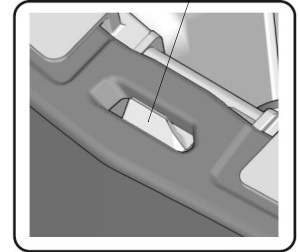
9. Release the retaining tabs.

- Any oil or dirt remaining on the front bumper will affect the performance of the adhesive tape, which could cause gaps or trim lifting.
- Allow to dry thoroughly.



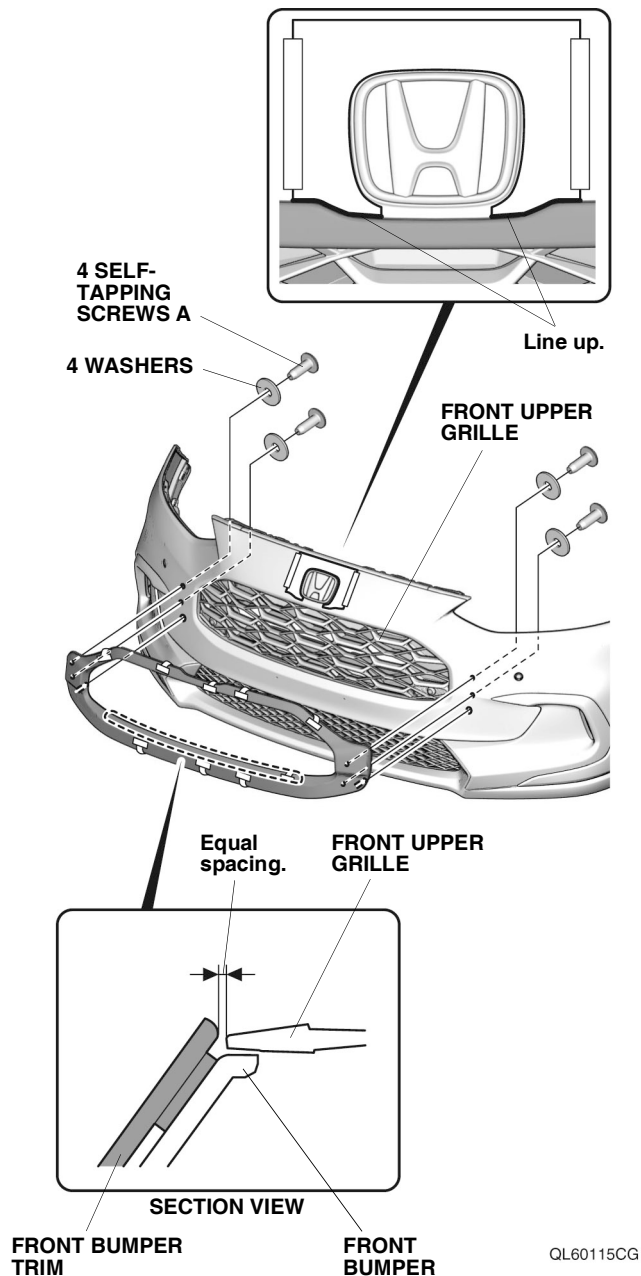
24. Temporarily attach the adhesive backings.



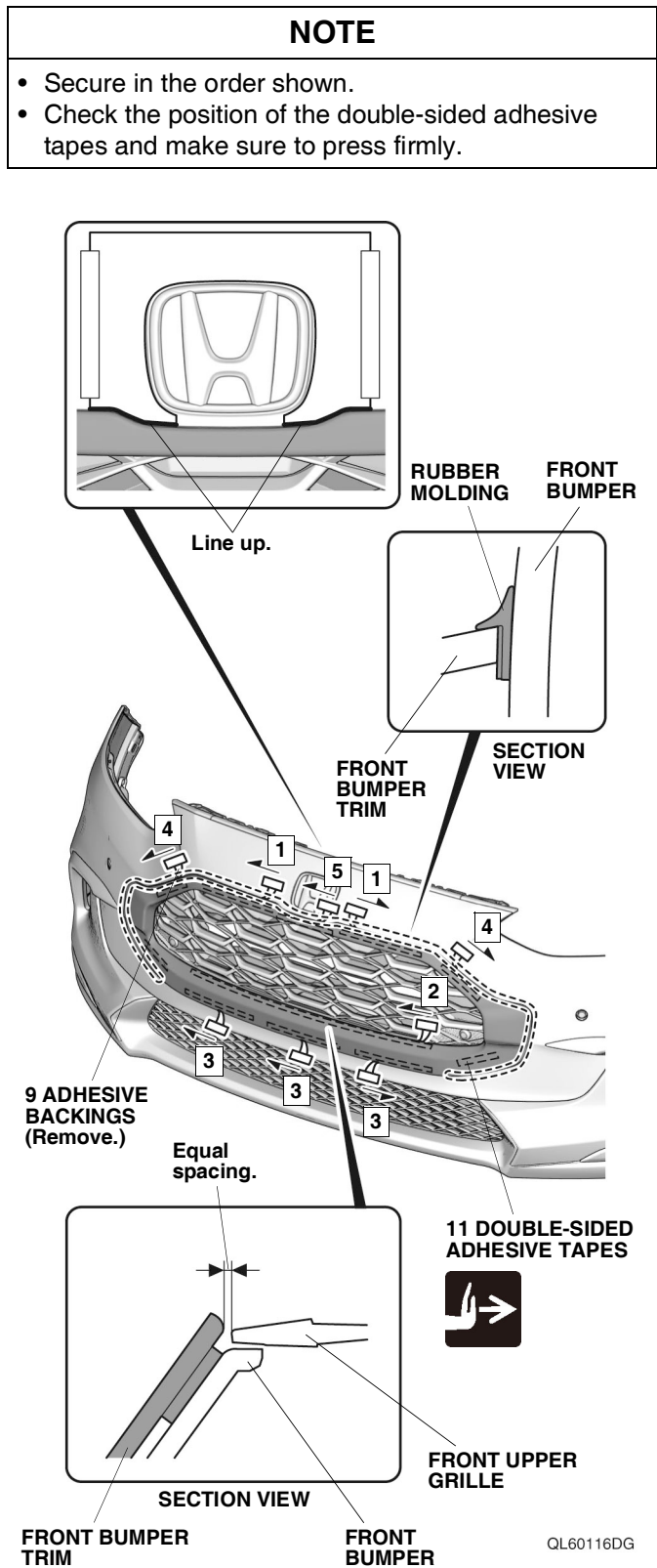

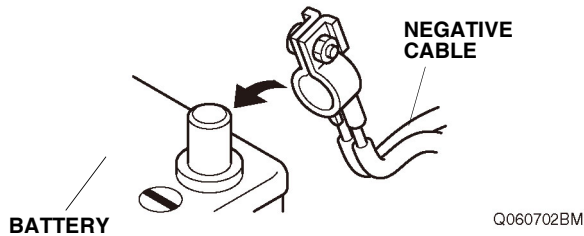
33. Check that all parts are installed and properly routed.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Check that all harnesses are not pulled or pinched.</li><li>• Make sure all clips and wire ties are securely installed.</li></ul>



34. Install all removed parts.

35. Connect the negative cable to the battery.



36. Make sure all accessories and systems operate properly.
37. If necessary, restore the systems back to normal operation as described in the service information.
38. Press and hold the audio unit power button for 2 seconds to restore the audio and navi (if equipped) system functions.
