



Installing the Front Splash Guards


1. Turn the steering wheel fully counterclockwise.


2. Remove the self-tapping screw and clip from the left front inner fender.

3. Using a pushpin, pierce the center of the clip on the left front inner fender.

4. Secure the left front splash guard with two self-tapping screws and one clip as shown. NOTE: Make sure there is no gap between the left front splash guard and the vehicle body. If there is one, loosen the self-tapping screws, hold the splash guard against the body, and retighten the screws.




Installing the Rear Splash Guards

5. Remove the two self-tapping screws and one clip from the rear bumper.



6. Locate the one dimple. Using a pushpin, pierce the rear bumper at the dimple.




7. Install one spring nut to the rear bumper as shown. NOTE: Make sure to install the spring nut in the correct position with the large hole facing out.

8. Secure the left rear splash guard with three self-tapping screws and one clip as shown.
NOTE: Make sure there is no gap between the left rear splash guard and the bumper. If there is one, loosen the self-tapping screws, hold the splash guard against the bumper, and retighten the screws.



9. Turn the steering wheel fully clockwise, and repeat steps 2 through 8 to install the right splash guards.
