Illustration of the Automatic Day/Night Mirror on the Vehicle






- 1. Disconnect the negative cable from the battery:
  - Wrap a shop towel around the hood latch lever.





· Remove the front bulkhead cover.




- Remove the intake air tube.
- Disconnect the negative cable from the battery.




- 2. Remove the roof console:
  - Using a small flat-tip screwdriver wrapped with a shop towel, pry out and remove the left and right lenses.
  - Open the sunglass holder, and remove the four screws.
  - Remove the roof console, and unplug the vehicle connectors.



3. Remove the camera cover lid.




4. Remove the camera cover.




5. Remove the rearview mirror as shown.



6. Remove the tape to free the vehicle 8-pin connector.




 Install the automatic day/night mirror to the mirror mount as shown.



 Route the vehicle harness through the cutout on the headliner


NOTE: Be careful not to crease the headliner.



9. Plug the vehicle 8-pin connector into the automatic day/night mirror 8-pin connector.

10. Secure the vehicle harness to the four holders on the sensor cover base as shown.

NOTE: Make sure that the vehicle harness are not pinched.



- 11. Check that all wire harnesses are routed properly and all connectors are plugged in.
- 12. Install all removed parts except for the front bulkhead cover and the intake air tube.
- 13. Connect the negative cable to the battery.
- 14. Install the front bulkhead cover and the intake air tube.
- 15. Press and hold the audio unit power button for 2 seconds to restore the audio and navi (if equipped) system functions.
- 16. Set the clock on vehicles without navigation.
- 17. If necessary, restore the systems back to normal operation as described in the service information.

### **Check the Operation of the Automatic Day/Night Mirror**

 Check that the automatic day/night mirror work properly as described in the Owner's Manual of the vehicle.
