

#### **GENERAL VIEW**

If you are also installing door lower trim, install them before you install the fender flares.



#### Procedure and Location Icons

Wear eye protection.



Wear heavy gloves.



Use an assistant.



Place the part on a blanket.



Work perpendicular.



Remove any burrs.



Use touch-up paint and allow to dry.



Tighten to the specified torque.



Apply firm pressure while rolling, especially at the ends, to set the adhesive.



Press firmly.



Clean with isopropyl alcohol.



Return the original part to the customer. (Do not reuse.)

#### Safety: General

- Observe all safety notes and precautions described in the service information, in addition to those described in this Installation Instruction. Be extremely careful for your safety and safety of others.
- Be careful not to damage the vehicle or the parts.
- Be extremely careful when handling retaining tabs and clips.
- Note the locations of the parts before removing them so they can be properly installed in their original positions.
- The illustrations may differ slightly from the actual accessory.

#### Safety: Electric Parts

Always disconnect the negative cable from the battery before beginning work.

### Safety: Accessory

- Always use the parts and tools specified in the installation instructions.
- Do not install the accessory on a dirty surface or in direct sunlight.
- Make sure the ambient air temperature is 60°F (15°C) or above when installing accessories that use adhesive material.
- When pressing the accessory firmly with the palm of your hand, be careful not to damage it or the vehicle.
- When applying adhesive material, make sure it is lined up properly before attaching. Once the adhesive material touches the surface, do not try to remove it. If you do, you could damage the part.
- Do not wash the vehicle for 24 hours to allow the adhesive to cure.

- 70. Connect the negative cable to the battery.



- 71. Install the front bulkhead cover and intake air tube.
- 72. Make sure all accessories and systems operate properly.
- 73. If necessary, restore the systems back to normal operation as described in the service information.
- 74. Press and hold the audio unit power button for 2 seconds to restore the audio and navi (if equipped) system functions.
