

Wire Harness Routing Precaution

Do not pinch the harness.	Cut off the excess wire tie.

Airbag

Adjust the tilt of the steering column to its lowest position. Then bring the telescope position to all the way out.











MOTICE

If you thread the steering wheel puller bolts into the wheel hole more than 5 threads, the bolts will hit the cable reel and damage it. To prevent this, install a pair of jam nuts 5 threads up on each puller bolt.

Confirm that the front wheels are aligned straight-ahead, and use a steering wheel puller to remove the steering wheel.



Remove the old sealant from the threads in the steering column shaft.


Steering Column Upper Cover

To prevent damage, do not remove the masking tape until after the parts are installed.












































Installing All Removed Parts

Operation Check

51 Connect the negative cable to the battery.





- 52 Install the resonator.
- Turn the ENGINE START/STOP button to ON; the SRS indicator should come on for about 6 seconds and then go off.

Vehicle Check

- Vehicle Check
 - Make sure the horn and steering wheel switches work properly.
 - Rotate the new steering wheel and check for abnormal noise.
 - Make sure the new steering wheel and the front wheels are in the straight-ahead position. If the spoke angle of the new steering wheel is not in the straight-ahead position with the front wheels, adjust the front toe as described in the service information.
 - Make sure the accessory operates as described in the vehicle owner's manual.
 - Make sure all accessories and systems operate properly.
 - 59 If necessary, restore the systems back to normal operation as described in the service information.
 - Press and hold the audio unit power button for 2 seconds to restore the audio and navi (if equipped) system functions.
