



- Plastic Plug
  - Remove the plastic plugs.








#### Installing the Roof Platform

2 Install the right front bracket and right rear bracket.

**S** NOTE

Check the identification mark and the installation position of the bracket.





RIGHT ROOF RAIL

RIGHT FRONT BRACKET (identification mark: FR-R)

RIGHT REAR BRACKET (identification mark: RR-R)


FLANGE BOLT(4)


Repeat step 2 on the other side.




Place the blanket to protect the vehicle.







### 5 Install the wind deflector.




٩	WIND DEFLECTOR (Slide rearward and install.)

В	SHOULDER BOLT(4)


6 Loosely install the roof platform.



Center the roof platform on the vehicle as necessary.










Secure the roof platform.

#### **S** NOTE

- When using some special tools or crowfoot-type wrenches, the torque value changes due to the added leverage. The actual torque applied will be greater than the torque reading shown.
  - The torque specification given is the actual torque, not the reading on the torque wrench.
  - To compensate for this additional leverage, use the formula below to calculate the torque value reading on the torque wrench.
  - Always use the special tool or crowfoot-type wrench in a straight line with the torque wrench, or you will apply improper torque.
