

Safety: Accessory

- Do not install the accessory on a dirty surface or in direct sunlight.
- Make sure the ambient air temperature is 60°F (15°C) or above when installing accessories that use adhesive material.
- When pressing the accessory firmly with the palm of your hand, be careful not to damage it or the vehicle.
- When applying adhesive material, make sure it is lined up properly before attaching. Once the adhesive material touches the surface, do not try to remove it. If you do, you could damage the part.




INSTALLATION

Removing the Vehicle Parts

- Left Headliner Cap/Right Headliner Cap
 - Remove the left headliner cap.









Repeat step 1 on the other side.

Installing the Separation Barrier

Clean the attaching area.







Attach the felt seal.

Pre-install the flange bolt into the left upper bracket to prevent it from falling when installing the left upper bracket.


WARNING

- Items dropped in the headliner can become projectiles when the side curtain airbag deploys, causing serious injury or death.
- Take steps to avoid dropping items, such as the flange bolt, into the headliner and if such items are dropped immediately retrieve them.



Check the identification mark and the installation position of the upper bracket.





Loosely install the handles A and collars.






Make sure to install the side brackets in the correct position.






Install the separation barrier.

- Make sure to install the separation barrier in the correct location.






