This product is designed to be used exclusively on a Honda PASSPORT. Honda is not responsible if the product is used for anything other than its intended purpose.

This manual should be considered a permanent part of the vehicle. It should remain with the vehicle at all times and stay with the vehicle when sold.

#### **▲** WARNING


- Failure to properly install or use this barrier can result in serious injury or death.
  - · Do not place cargo between the sides of the vehicle and the sides of the separation barrier.
  - · Never attach anything to, or hang anything from, the separation barrier or its hardware.
  - · Completely install all brackets and hardware when using the separation barrier.
  - · Arrow labels on the separation barrier always should be pointing up and towards the front of the vehicle.
  - Completely remove all brackets and hardware from the vehicle mounting positions when uninstalling the separation barrier.

## Installation

1 Install the separation barrier through the tailgate opening.

#### NOTE:

- · Be careful not to scratch the interior.
- Make sure to check the arrow label.




A	LEFT REAR SIDE TRIM PANEL, RIGHT REAR SIDE TRIM PANEL

2 Insert the upper mounting hardware into the hole at both sides of the headliner.

#### NOTE:


- Be careful not to scratch the interior.
- Ensure that the hardware is set all the way forward in the headliner mounting feature.

Α	Slide to the front side of the vehicle.


## Installation


3 Slide the bracket into the left rear side trim panel until the tab of the bracket is passed arrow. Tighten the knob to secure the bracket. Repeat the same procedures on the other side.

4 Tighten the two knobs.





## Installation

#### NOTE:

- Check all of the mounting hardware frequently and retighten if necessary.
- Ensure that the upper mounting hardware is positioned correctly in the headliner mounts before retightening.
