#### Illustration of the CD Player Unit on the Vehicle






1. Wrap a shop towel around the hood latch.

- Disconnect the negative cable from the battery.




2. Pull away the door opening seal, and remove the passenger's dashboard side lid.

DOOR OPENING SEAL (Pull away.)


PASSENGER'S DASHBOARD SIDE LID






18. Install the accessory socket removed in step 12 to the new accessory socket and USB socket holder or new accessory socket holder.



19. Install the left and right brackets on the CD player unit with four 5 x 7 mm flange bolts.



20. Remove the tape from the vehicle harness.



- Plug the vehicle connector, and secure the vehicle harness to the right bracket with clip on the vehicle harness.
- 22. Install the CD player unit to the dashboard with two 6 mm bolts and four self-tapping screws removed in step 10.

- 23. Check that all wire harnesses are routed properly and all connectors are plugged in.
- 24. Reinstall all removed parts except for the front bulkhead cover and the intake air tube.
- 25. Reconnect the negative cable to the battery.
- 26. Reinstall the front bulkhead cover and the intake air tube.
- 27. Press and hold the audio power button for two seconds to restore the audio and navi (if equipped) system functions.
- 28. Reset the clock on vehicle without navigation.
- 29. Restore the systems back to normal operation as described in the Service Manual if necessary.

### Check the Operation of the CD player unit

30. Check the operation of the CD player unit according to the vehicle Owner's Manual.
