

#### Illustration of the Bumper Trim on the Vehicle




#### **INSTALLATION**

**Customer Information:** The information in this installation instruction is intended for use only by skilled technicians who have the proper tools, equipment, and training to correctly and safely add equipment to your vehicle. These procedures should not be attempted by "do-it-yourselfers."

- 1. Disconnect the negative cable from the battery:
  - Wrap a shop towel around the hood latch.




Remove the front bulkhead cover.




- Remove the intake air tube.

2. Remove the three self-tapping screws.




3. Remove the left front wheel arch protector.




- 4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 on the right side of the vehicle.
- 5. Remove the front bumper:


Using a flat-tip screwdriver, remove the H emblem.




· Remove the front upper grille.




Apply masking tape as shown.




 Remove the four self-tapping screws, eight clips, and eight flange bolts.




• With the help of an assistant, release the seven retaining tabs on each side.




· Release the front grille.




- With the help of an assistant, remove the front bumper, and unplug the vehicle connectors.
- Place the front bumper on a blanket.



6. Remove the left front bumper trim from the front bumper.




 Install the new left front bumper trim to the front bumper with two self-tapping screws and three retaining tabs.




8. Repeat steps 6 and 7 on the right side of the front bumper.


9. Remove the left rear reflector from the rear bumper.



10. Remove the left rear bumper trim from the rear bumper.



11. Install the new left rear bumper trim to the rear bumper with two self-tapping screws and five retaining tabs.



- 12. Repeat steps 9 through 11 on the right side of the vehicle.
- 13. Check that all wire harnesses are routed properly and all connectors are plugged in.
- 14. Install all removed parts except for the front bulkhead cover and the intake air tube.
- 15. Connect the negative cable to the battery.
- Install the front bulkhead cover and the intake air tube.
- 17. Press and hold the audio unit power button for 2 seconds to restore the audio and navi (if equipped) system functions.
- 18. Set the clock on vehicles without navigation.
- 19. If necessary, restore the systems back to normal operation as described in the service information.
