

#### Procedure and Location Icons

Wear eye protection.



Wear heavy gloves.

Apply firm pressure while rolling, especially at the ends, to set the adhesive.



Press firmly.



Clean with isopropyl alcohol.



Return the original part to the customer. (Do not reuse.)


### Wire Harness Routing Precaution



Do not secure the accessory harness to the SRS harness. (except for instruction cases.)



Push the connectors and terminals together until they lock.



Do not pull the harness to unplug the connectors.



Install removed connectors in their original location.



Do not pull the harness.




Secure the accessory harness as shown.





Do not pinch the harness.



Cut off the excess wire tie.

### Safety: General

### Safety: Electric Parts


Always disconnect the negative cable from the battery before beginning work.

#### Safety: Accessory

- · Always use the parts and tools specified in the installation instructions.
- · Do not install the accessory on a dirty surface or in direct sunlight.
- Make sure the ambient air temperature is 60°F (15°C) or above when installing accessories that use adhesive material.
- When pressing the accessory firmly with the palm of your hand, be careful not to damage it or the vehicle.
- When applying adhesive material, make sure it is lined up properly before attaching. Once the adhesive material
  touches the surface, do not try to remove it. If you do, you could damage the part.
- Do not wash the vehicle or moisten it for 24 hours to allow the adhesive to cure.




1. Remove the resonator.




2. Disconnect the negative cable from the battery.

#### **NOTE**

With the driver's door open, turn the vehicle to the OFF (LOCK) mode, then wait at least 3 minutes before disconnecting the 12 volt negative battery cable.

3. Attach masking tape to protect the vehicle.



23. Check that all parts are installed and properly routed.

#### **NOTE**

- · Check that all harnesses are not pulled or pinched.
- Make sure all clips and wire ties are securely installed.
- 24. Install all removed parts except for the resonator.
- 25. Connect the negative cable to the battery.



- 26. Install the resonator.
- 27. Make sure the light comes on when you open each door.
- 28. Make sure all accessories and systems operate properly.
- 29. If necessary, restore the systems back to normal operation as described in the service information.
- 30. Press and hold the audio unit power button for 2 seconds to restore the audio and navi (if equipped) system functions.
