

If you are also installing trailer hitch harness, install it before you install the trailer hitch.


The location on the vehicle.

Wire Harness Routing Precaution




Do not secure the accessory harness to the SRS harness. (except for instruction cases.)



Press firmly.

(Do not reuse.)

Push the connectors and terminals together until they lock.



Do not pull the harness to unplug the connectors.



Install removed connectors in their original location.



Do not pull the harness.




Secure the accessory harness as shown.





Do not pinch the harness.



Cut off the excess wire tie.

Safety: General


Always disconnect the negative cable from the battery before beginning work.

Safety: Accessory


- Always use the parts and tools specified in the installation instructions.
- · Do not install the accessory on a dirty surface or in direct sunlight.
- Make sure the ambient air temperature is 60°F (15°C) or above when installing accessories that use adhesive material.
- · When pressing the accessory firmly with the palm of your hand, be careful not to damage it or the vehicle.
- When applying adhesive material, make sure it is lined up properly before attaching. Once the adhesive material
 touches the surface, do not try to remove it. If you do, you could damage the part.
- Do not wash the vehicle for 24 hours to allow the adhesive to cure.


2. Disconnect the negative cable from the battery.


NOTE

With the driver's door open, turn the vehicle to the OFF (LOCK) mode, then wait at least 3 minutes before disconnecting the 12 volt negative battery cable.











- 4. Remove the self-tapping screws.






5. Remove the left rear wheel arch protector.




7. Attach masking tape to protect the vehicle.


28. Tighten the flange bolts.

NOTE

- · Tighten in the order shown.
- Tighten the six flange bolts to an initial torque of 48 lb-ft (65 N·m) as shown. Then, tighten the flange bolts to a final torque of 96 lb-ft (130 N·m).
- After tightening all the flange bolts, recheck their torque.









32. Check that all parts are installed and properly routed.

NOTE

- Check that all harnesses are not pulled and not pinched.
- Make sure all clamps and wire ties are securely installed.
- 33. Install all removed parts except for the resonator.
- 34. Connect the negative cable to the battery.




- 35. Install the resonator.
- 36. Perform operation check by referring to the Accessory User's Information Manual (with Hands-Free Access unit).
- 37. Make sure all accessories and systems operate properly.
- 38. If necessary, restore the systems back to normal operation as described in the service information.
- 39. Press and hold the audio unit power button for 2 seconds to restore the audio and navi (if equipped) system functions.
- 40. Give the cover, ball mount, hitch pin, hitch pin clip, and Accessory User's Information Manual (with Hands-Free Access unit) to the customer.

TRAILER HITCH


Whenever you remove the hitch pin clip, the hitch pin, and the ball mount, store them securely in the cargo area. Install the cover into the opening at the end of the trailer hitch.

When you reinstall the ball mount, store the cover in the cargo area.

Install the ball mount into the trailer hitch using a hitch pin clip and hitch pin.



After the first 600 miles (1,000 km) of towing, have your Honda Dealer check the tightness of the trailer hitch bolts.
