





Installing the Front Splash Guards

Turn the steering wheel fully counterclockwise.








2 Remove the self-tapping screws.

Install the left front splash guard.

◆ NOTE

- · Make sure to install the spacer in the correct orientation.
- Make sure that there is no gap between the splash guard and vehicle body. If there is a gap, loosen the self-tapping screws, hold the splash guard against the vehicle body, and retighten the screws.
- · Make sure that the splash guard is properly installed.

Turn the steering wheel fully clockwise, and repeat steps 2 and 3 on the other side.




Installing the Rear Splash Guards

Remove the self-tapping screws.








6 Install the left rear splash guard.
