

Illustration of the Running Boards on the Vehicle





NOTE:


- Thoroughly clean the bottom of the body between the front and rear wheels.
- Be careful not to damage the body paint finish.
- 1. Using a utility knife, cut out the left side sill panel as shown. Remove any burrs.




2. Remove the undercoating as shown. Apply touch-up paint where you removed the undercoating, and allow it to dry thoroughly.




 Loosely install the left bracket A and left bracket C to the vehicle panel with four flange bolts.
NOTE: Make sure that the brackets are installed in the correct positions and orientations.



4. With the help of an assistant, install the left running board to the left bracket A and left bracket C with four flange bolts. Torque the flange bolts to 27 N·m (20 lb·ft).



5. Tighten the four flange bolts loosely installed in step 3. Torque the flange bolts to 27 N·m (20 lb·ft).



6. Repeat steps 1 through 5 on the right side of the vehicle.
