



- 1. Disconnect the negative cable from the battery:
  - Wrap a shop towel around the hood latch.







2. Pull away the door opening seal and remove the passenger's dashboard side lid.


DOOR OPENING SEAL (Pull away.) PASSENGER'S DASHBOARD SIDE LID




3. Open the glove box.




4. Remove the passenger's lower panel.




5. Pull away the door opening seal and remove the driver's dashboard side lid.




6. Remove the driver's dashboard lower cover and unplug the vehicle connectors and release the vehicle sensor.




7. Remove the center upper panel and unplug the vehicle connector.





13. Install the seat heater switches or lids to the CD player unit with four self-tapping screws removed in step11.






15. Install the accessory socket removed in step 12 to the accessory socket and 1 USB socket holder or the accessory socket holder with two retaining tabs.



16. Install the left and right brackets to the CD player unit with four 5 x 7 mm flange bolts.



17. Remove the tape to release the vehicle 16-pin connector. Plug the vehicle 16-pin connector into the CD player unit, and secure the vehicle harness to the right bracket with clip on the vehicle harness.



18. Install the CD player unit to the dashboard with four self-tapping screws removed in step 10 and the two 6 mm bolts supplied.

- 19. Check that all wire harnesses are routed properly and all connectors are plugged in.
- 20. Install all removed parts except for the front bulkhead cover and the intake air tube.
- 21. Connect the negative cable to the battery.
- 22. Install the front bulkhead cover and the intake air tube.
- 23. Press and hold the audio unit power button for 2 seconds to restore the audio and navi (if equipped) system functions.
- 24. Set the clock on vehicles without navigation.
- 25. If necessary, restore the system back to normal operation as described in the service information.

### **Check the Operation of the CD Player Unit**

26. Make sure the CD player unit works as described in the vehicle owner's manual.
