Procedure and Location Icons

Wear eye protection.



Wear heavy gloves.



Use an assistant.



Place the part on a blanket.



Work perpendicular.



Remove any burrs.



Use touch-up paint and allow to dry.



Tighten to the specified torque.



Apply firm pressure while rolling, especially at the ends, to set the adhesive.



Press firmly.



Clean with isopropyl alcohol.



Return the original part to the customer. (Do not use.)

Wire Harness Routing Precautions



Do not secure the accessory harness and SRS harness together. (except for instruction cases).



Push the connectors and terminals together until they lock.



Do not pull the harness to unplug the connectors.



Install removed connectors in their original location.



Do not pull the harness.



Secure the accessory harness as shown.





Do not pinch the harness.



Cut off the excess wire tie.

Safety: General

- Observe all safety notes and precautions described in the service information, in addition to those described in this Installation Instruction. Be extremely careful for your safety and safety of others.
- Be careful not to damage the vehicle or the parts.
- Be extremely careful when handling retaining tabs and clips.
- Note the locations of the parts before removing them so they can be properly installed in their original positions.


1. Wrap a shop towel.






6. Open the front driver side door and remove the left front wheel arch protector.

- 8. Repeat the same procedures for the other side.






10. Attach masking tape to protect the vehicle.


11. Remove the clips, bolts, and self-tapping screws.



12. Release the retaining tabs.



- Make sure to release the retaining tabs in the correct orientation.




13. Repeat step 12 for the other side.

14. Remove the front bumper.




15. Unplug the vehicle connector.




16. Release the vehicle harness.




26. Secure the vehicle harness.

NOTE

- Check that all harnesses are not pulled and not pinched.
- Make sure all clamps and wire ties are securely installed.
- 28. Install all removed parts except for the front bulkhead cover and intake air tube.
- 29. Connect the negative cable to the battery.



- 30. Install the front bulkhead cover and intake air tube.
- 31. Make sure all accessories and systems operate properly.
- 32. If necessary, restore the systems back to normal operation as described in the service information.
- 33. Press and hold the audio unit power button for 2 seconds to restore the audio and navi (if equipped) system functions.
