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Procedure and Location Icons

These icons indicate the work location and the worker's point of view. *All icons are not used in all installation instructions.



The location on the vehicle.



The location in the vehicle. (instrument panel.)

Wear heavy gloves.

Remove any burrs.

Press firmly.

Place the part on a blanket.

Tighten to the specified torque.



Wear eye protection.



Use an assistant.



Work perpendicular.



Use touch-up paint and allow to dry.



Apply firm pressure while rolling, especially at the ends, to set the adhesive.



Clean with isopropyl alcohol.

Safety: General

- · Be careful not to damage the vehicle or the parts.
- · The illustrations may differ slightly from the actual accessory.

Safety: Accessory


- · Do not install the accessory on a dirty surface or in direct sunlight.
- Make sure the ambient air temperature is 60°F (15°C) or above when installing accessories that use a bonding material.
- Be careful to keep the accessories to dry. If you wet them, the tapes and the films can not provide their performance fully since the adhesive backings remains on the adhesive side.
- When applying adhesive material, make sure it is lined up properly before attaching. Once the adhesive material touches the surface, do not try to remove it. If you do, you could damage the part before the adhesive releases.
- · Cover the around parts with the shop towel for not to wet.
- Use the 3M protective tape application solution with a spray bottle.
- Not to wash the vehicle for 24 hours to allow the adhesive to cure.



Return the original part to the customer. (Do not use.)



INSTALLATION


1. Clean the attaching area.

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
2. Spray the left front door.



3. Remove the adhesive backing.

NOTE

- Make sure to check the identification mark before installation.
- Always wear gloves when working with 3M protective tape application solution.




4. Spray the left front door handle film.

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5. Line up the left front door handle film.

NOTE

Check the identification mark, arrow mark and installation position of the door handle film. Make sure to install the door handle film in the correct position and orientation.



Secure the left front door handle film. 6.

7. Remove the protective film.



Wipe off the 3M protective tape application solution. 8.

NOTE


Allow to dry thoroughly.

- 9. Repeat steps 1 through 8 for the remaining door handle films except for the tailgate handle film.
- 10. Clean the attaching area.

Allow to dry thoroughly.

Always wear gloves when working with 3M protective tape application solution.








13. Spray the tailgate handle film.
